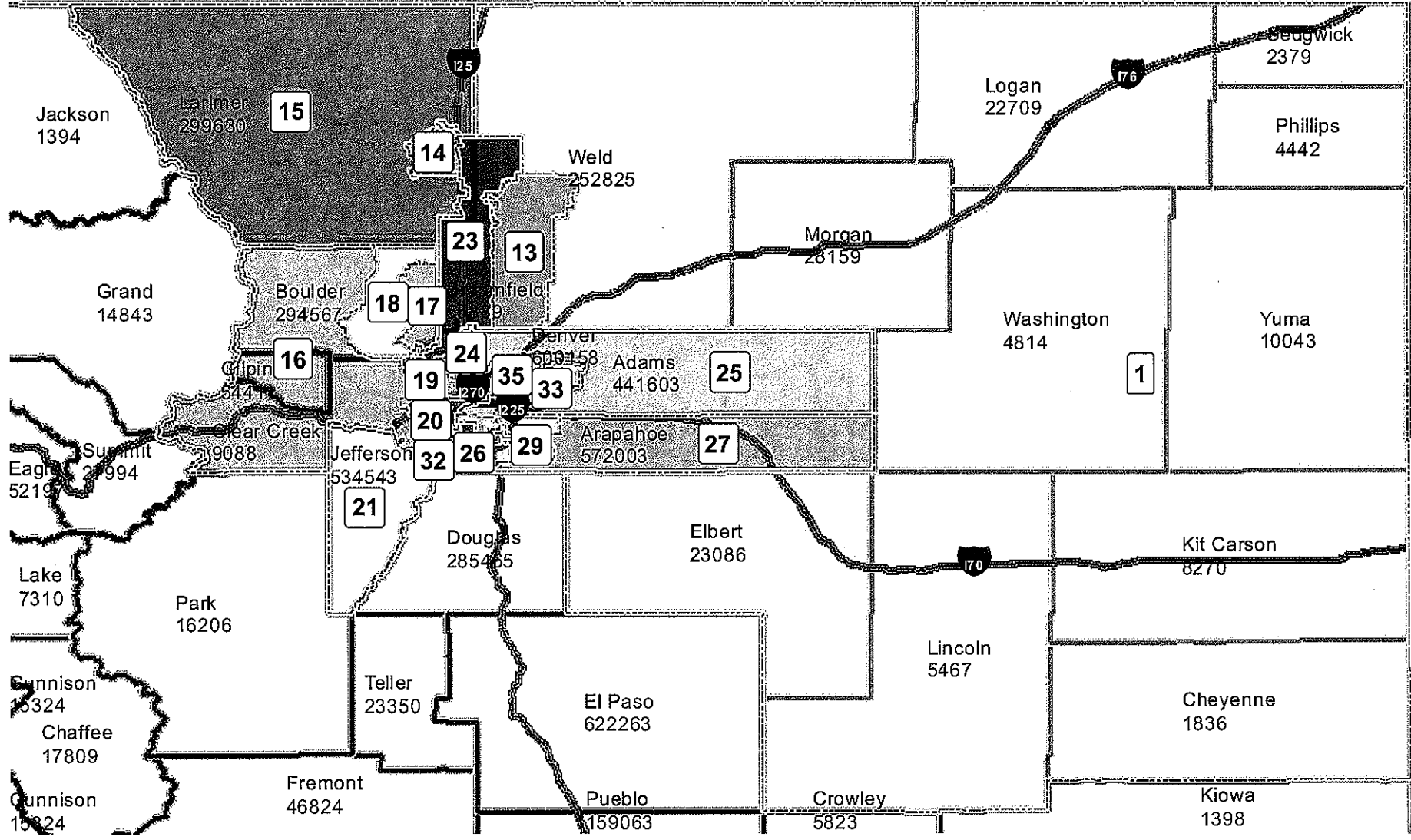

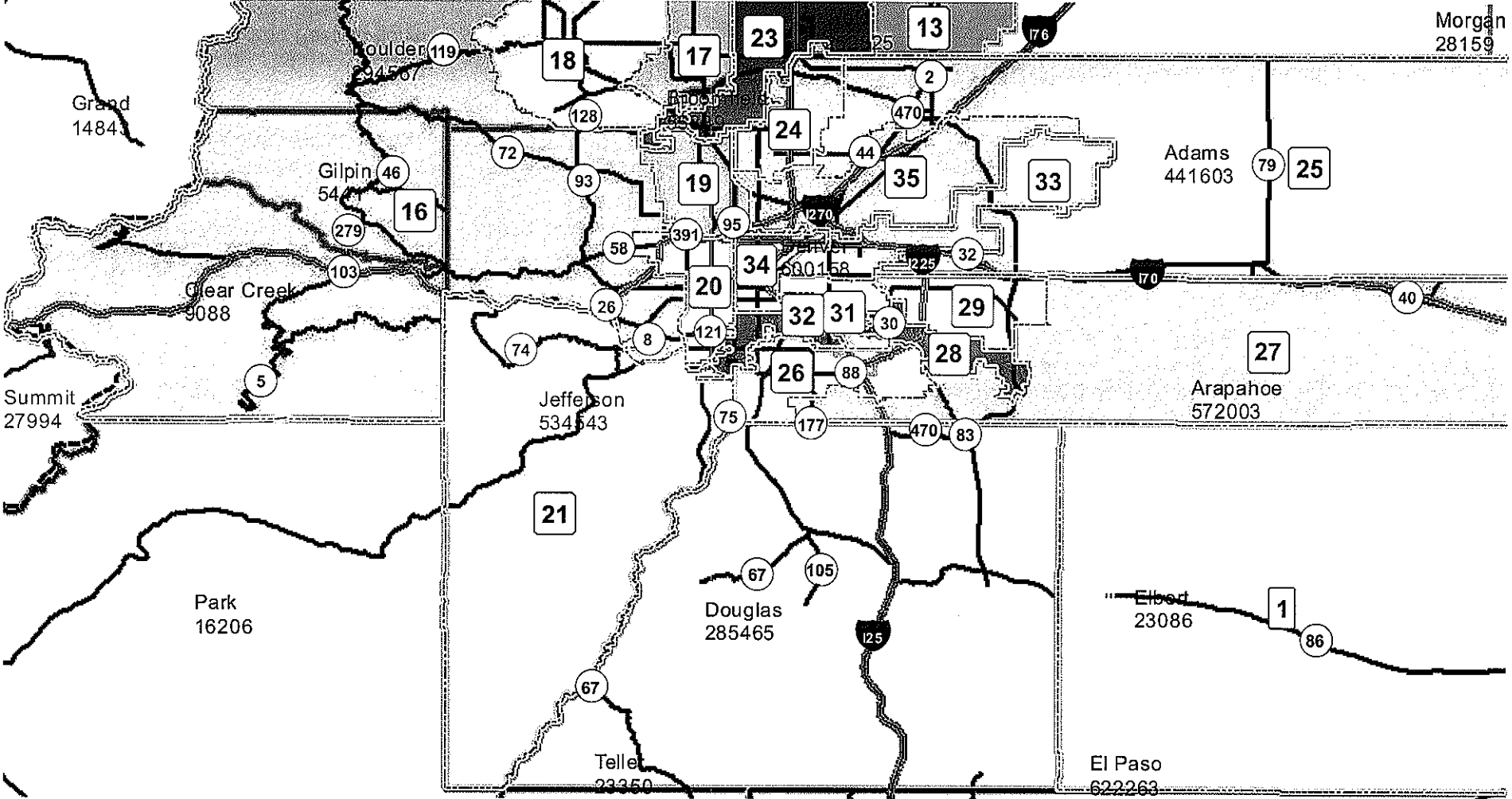

## Jeferson County Zoom

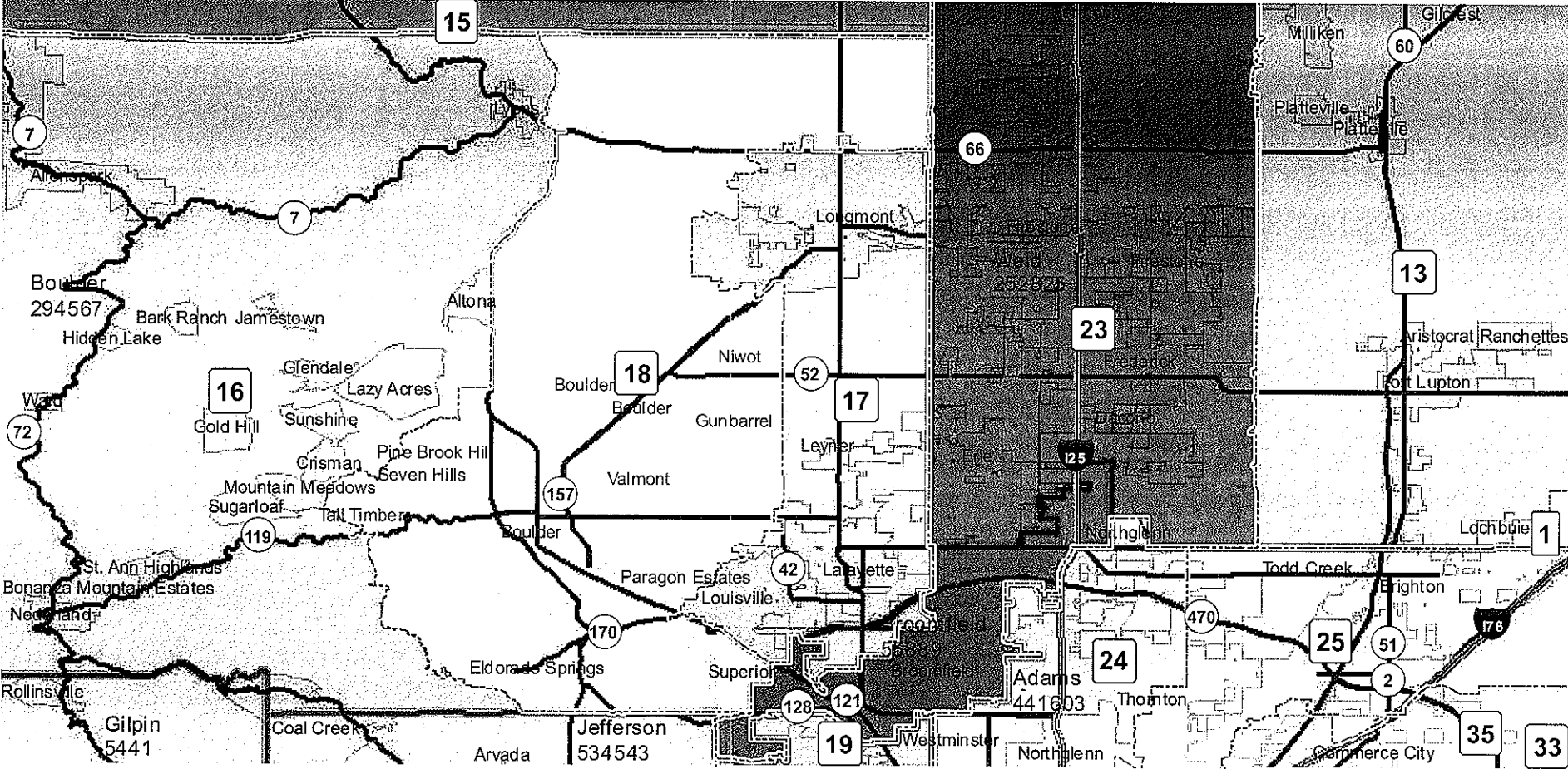

## Boulder Zoom

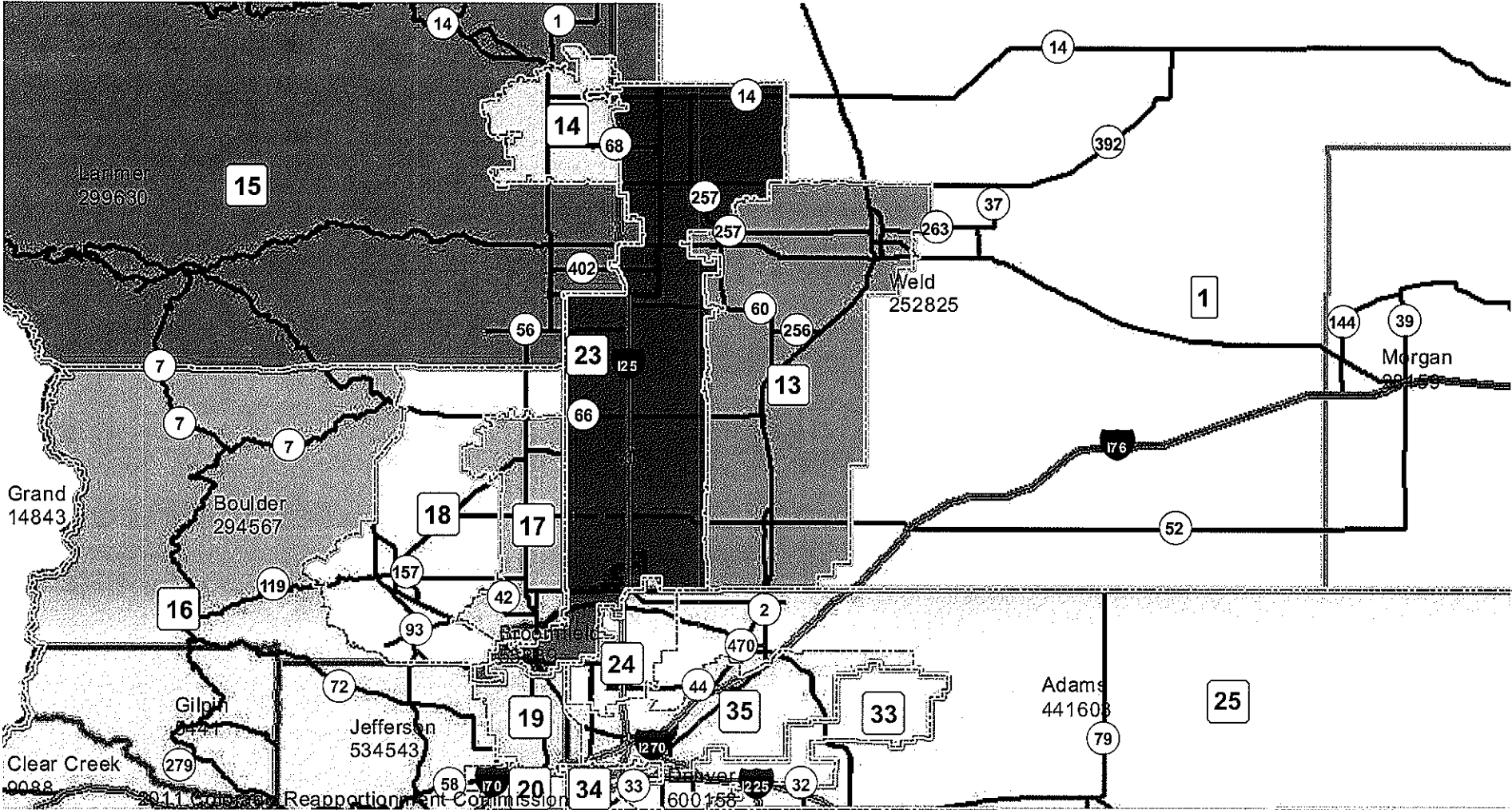

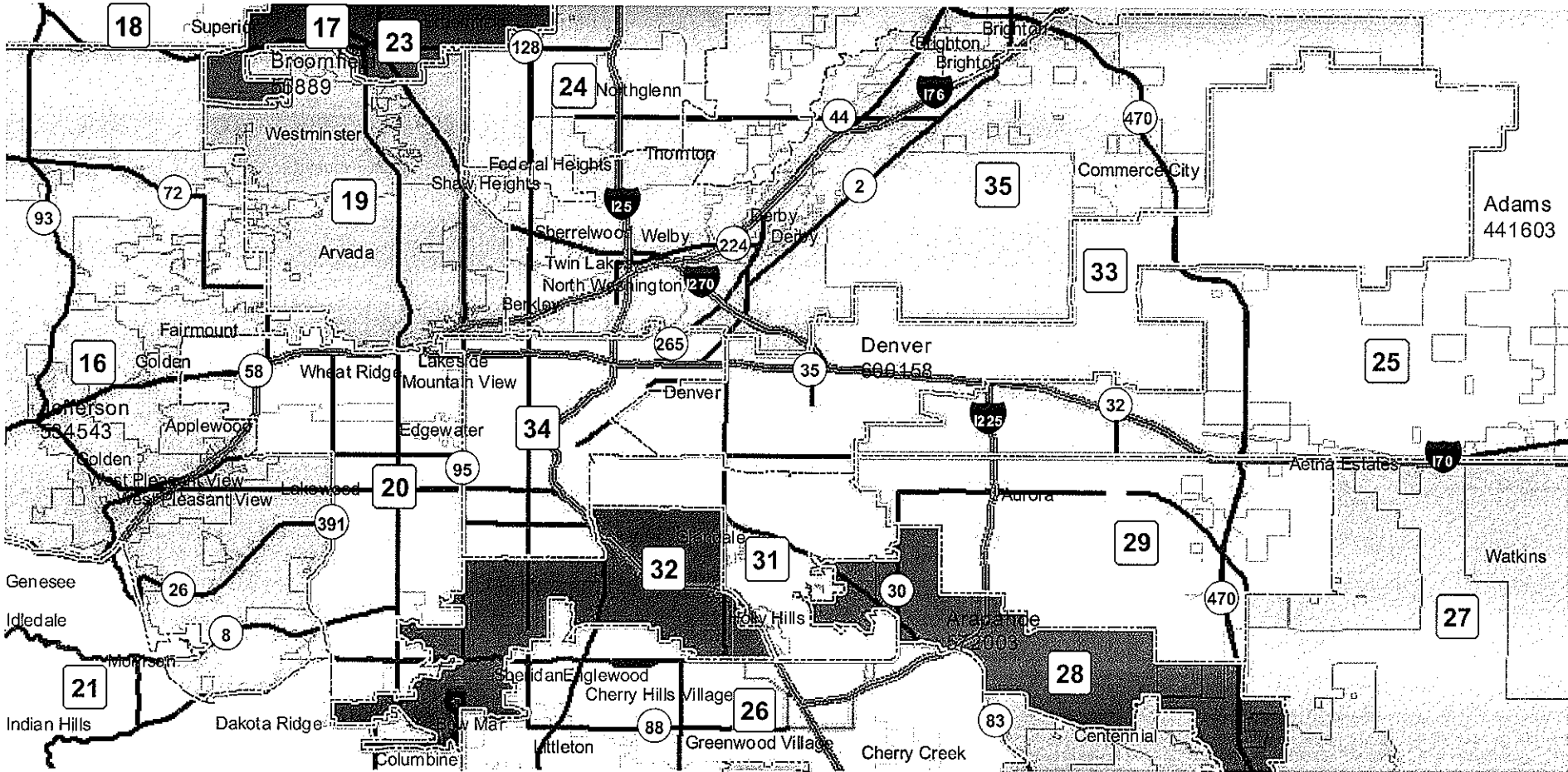

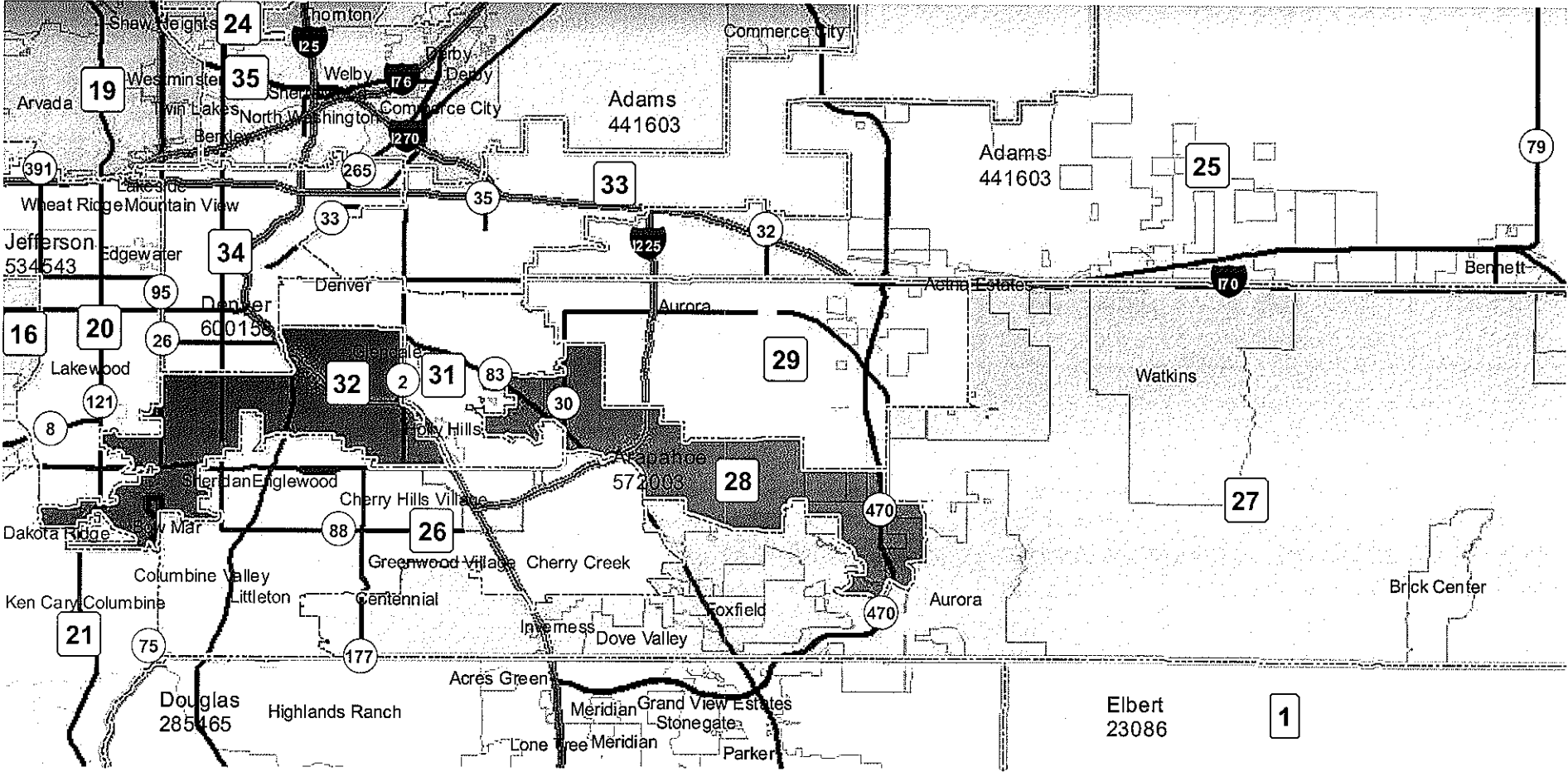
