Metro Area Zoom

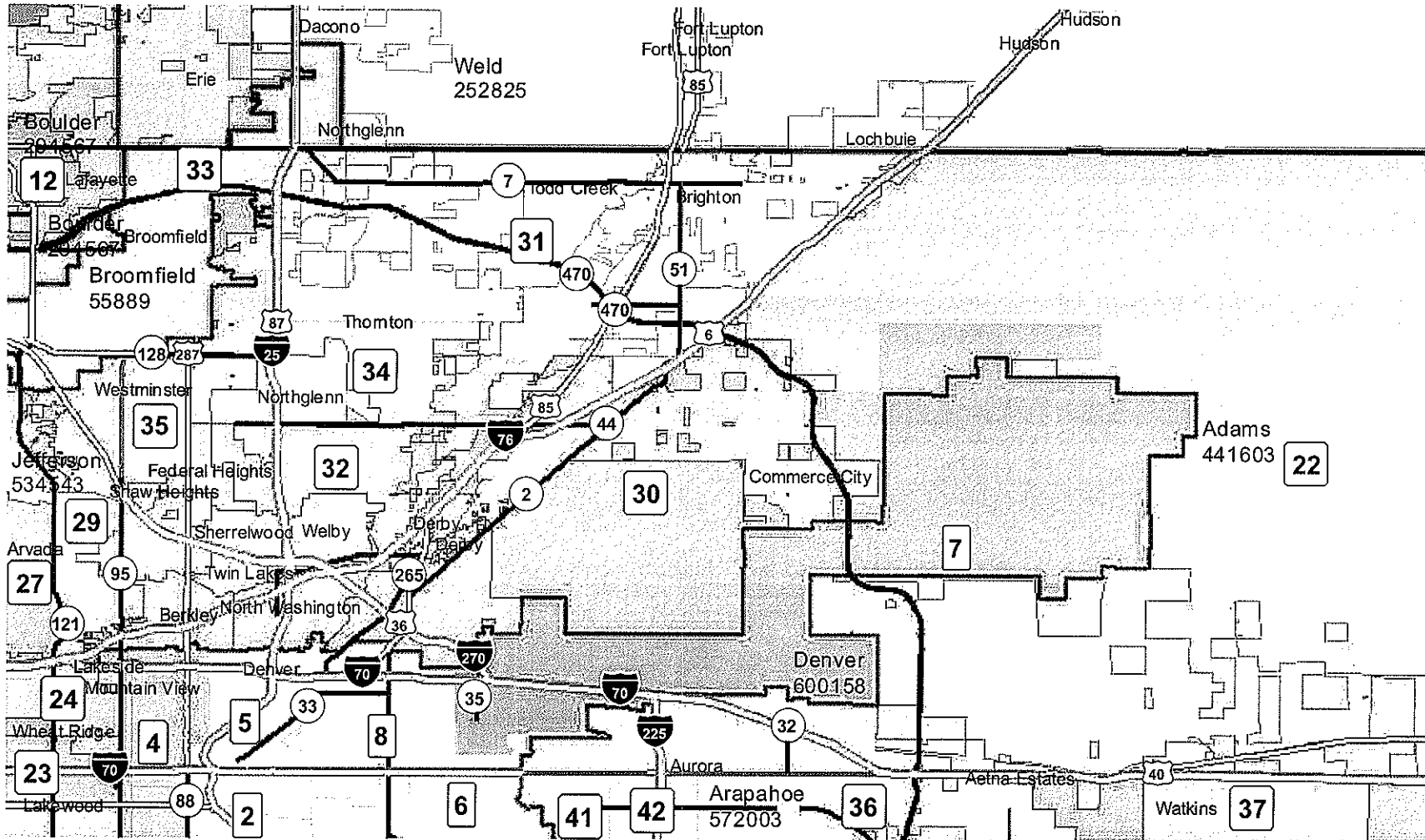

Western Adams County Zoom

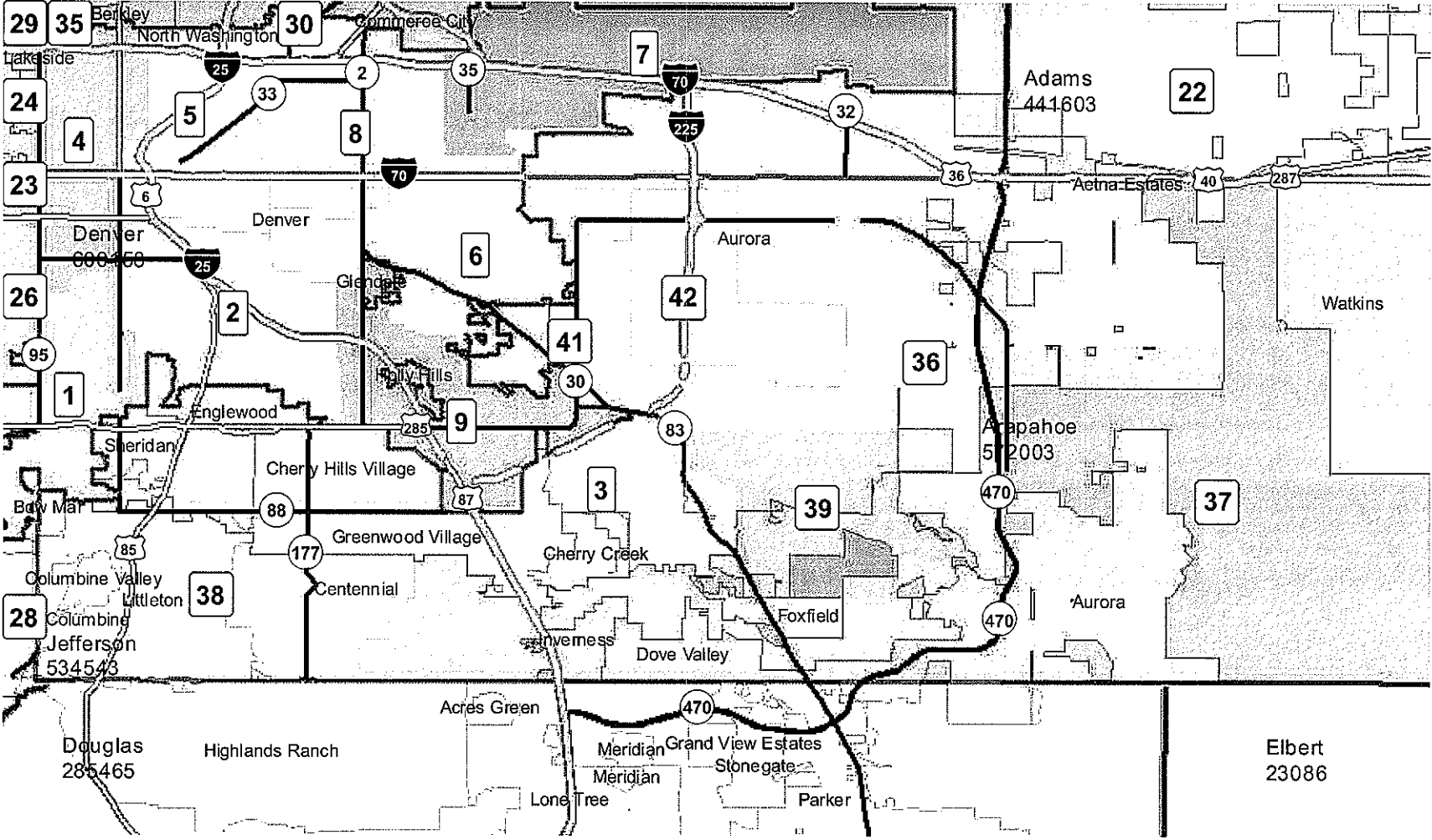

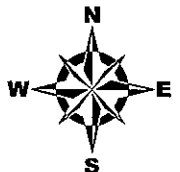
