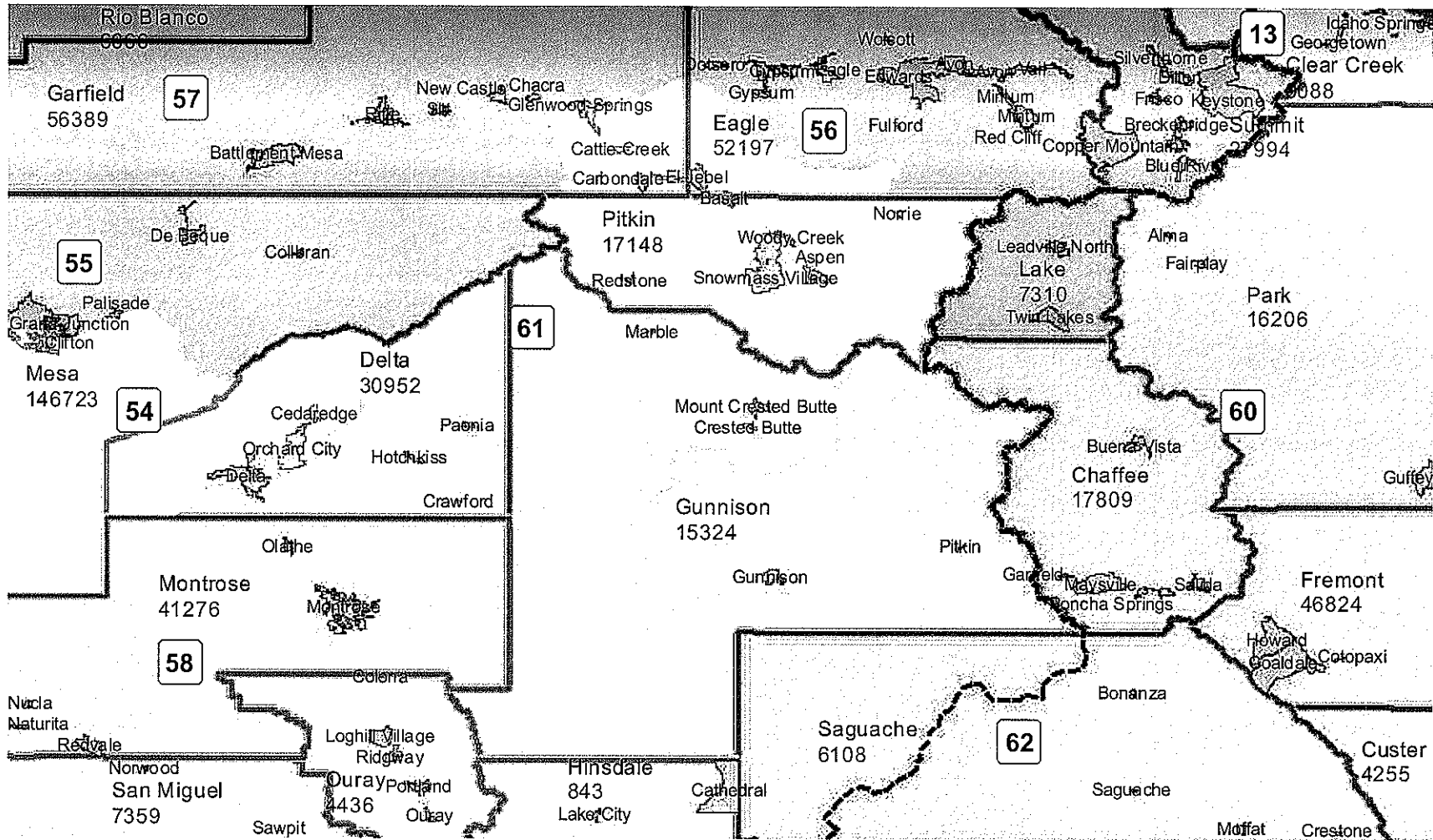
Statewide Preliminary Adopted House Plan Mesa and Delta County Zoom



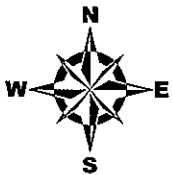

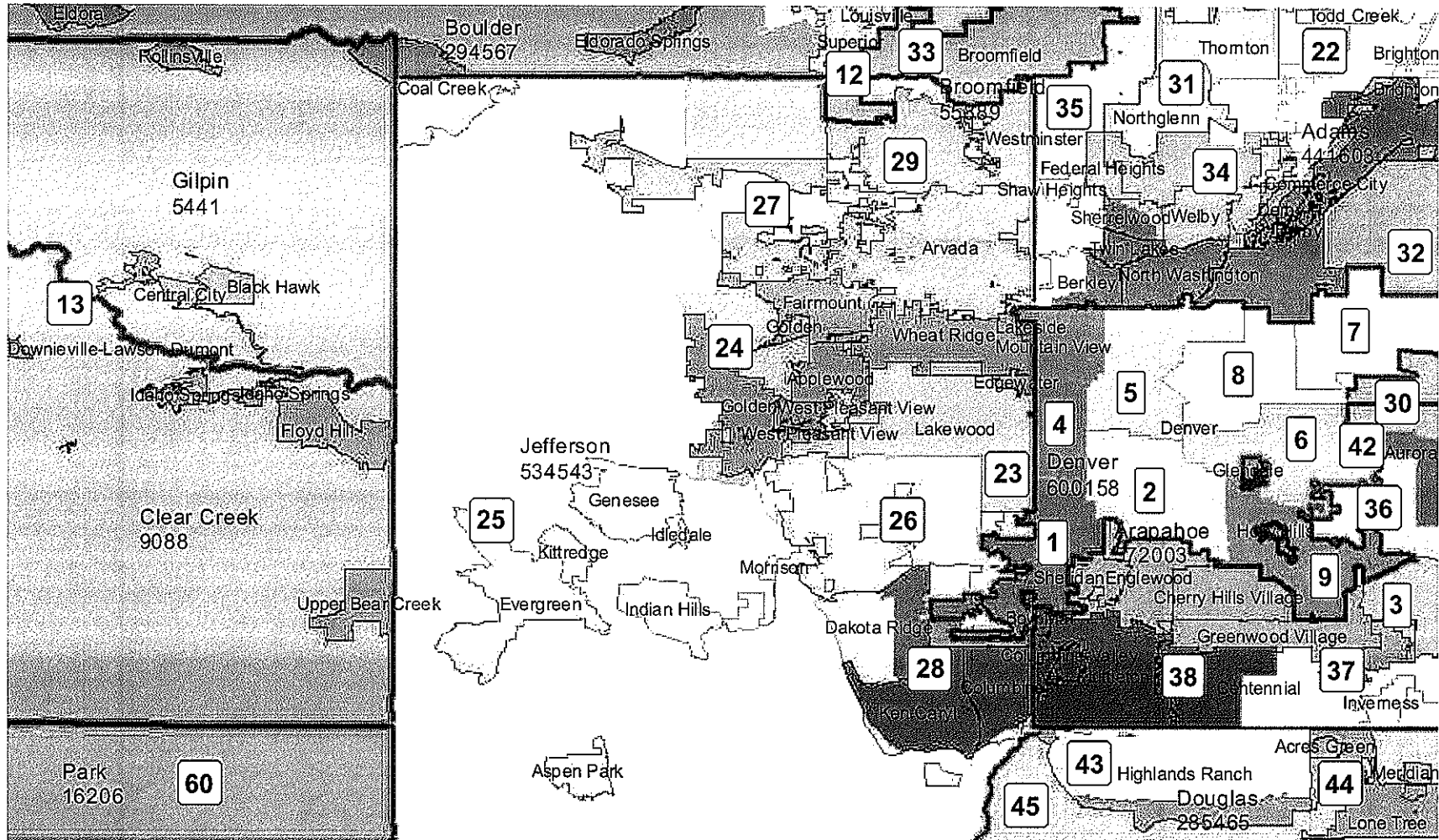
Statewide Preliminary Adopted House Plan Denver County Zoom



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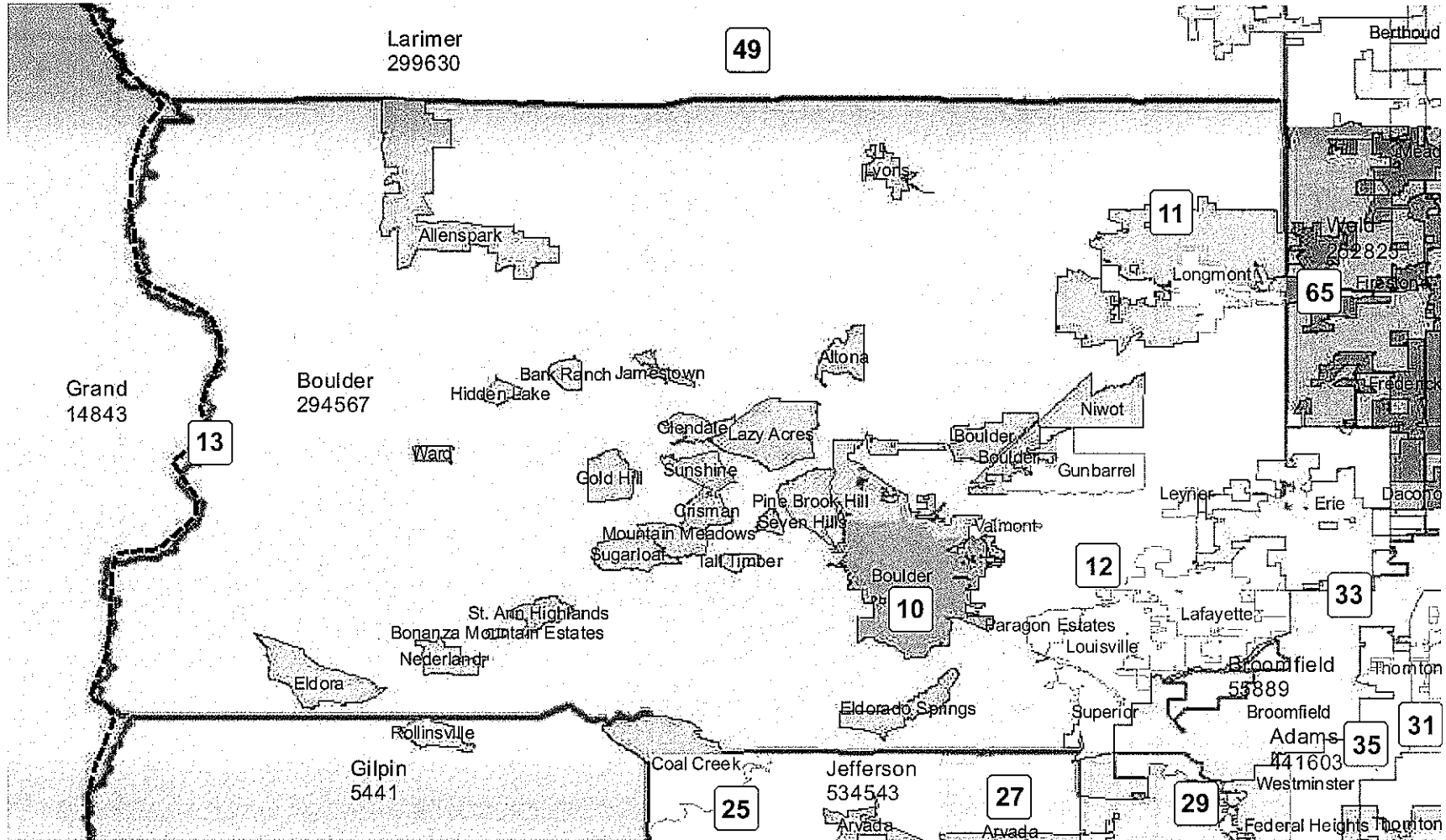
