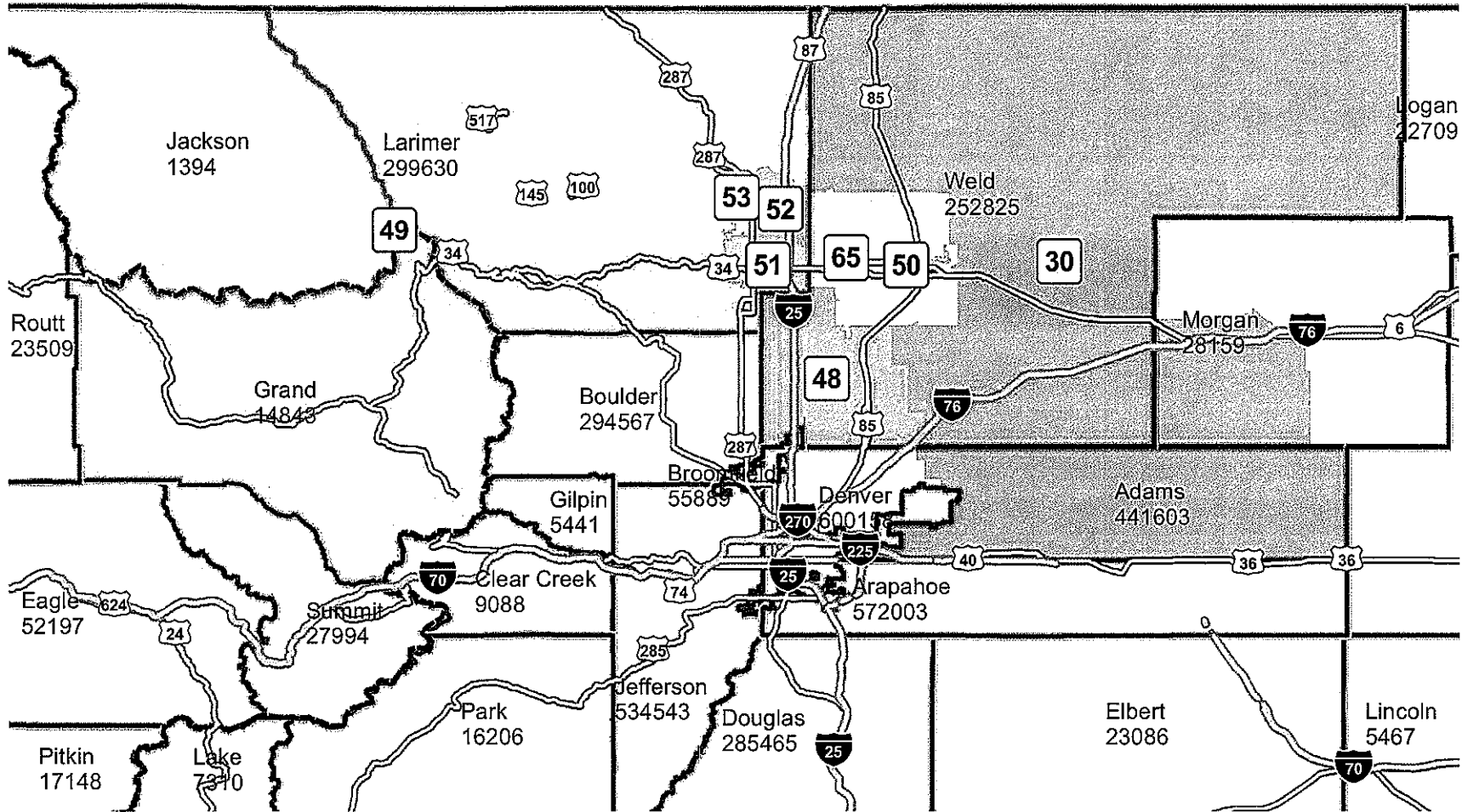
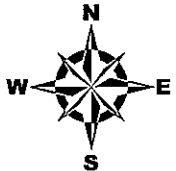

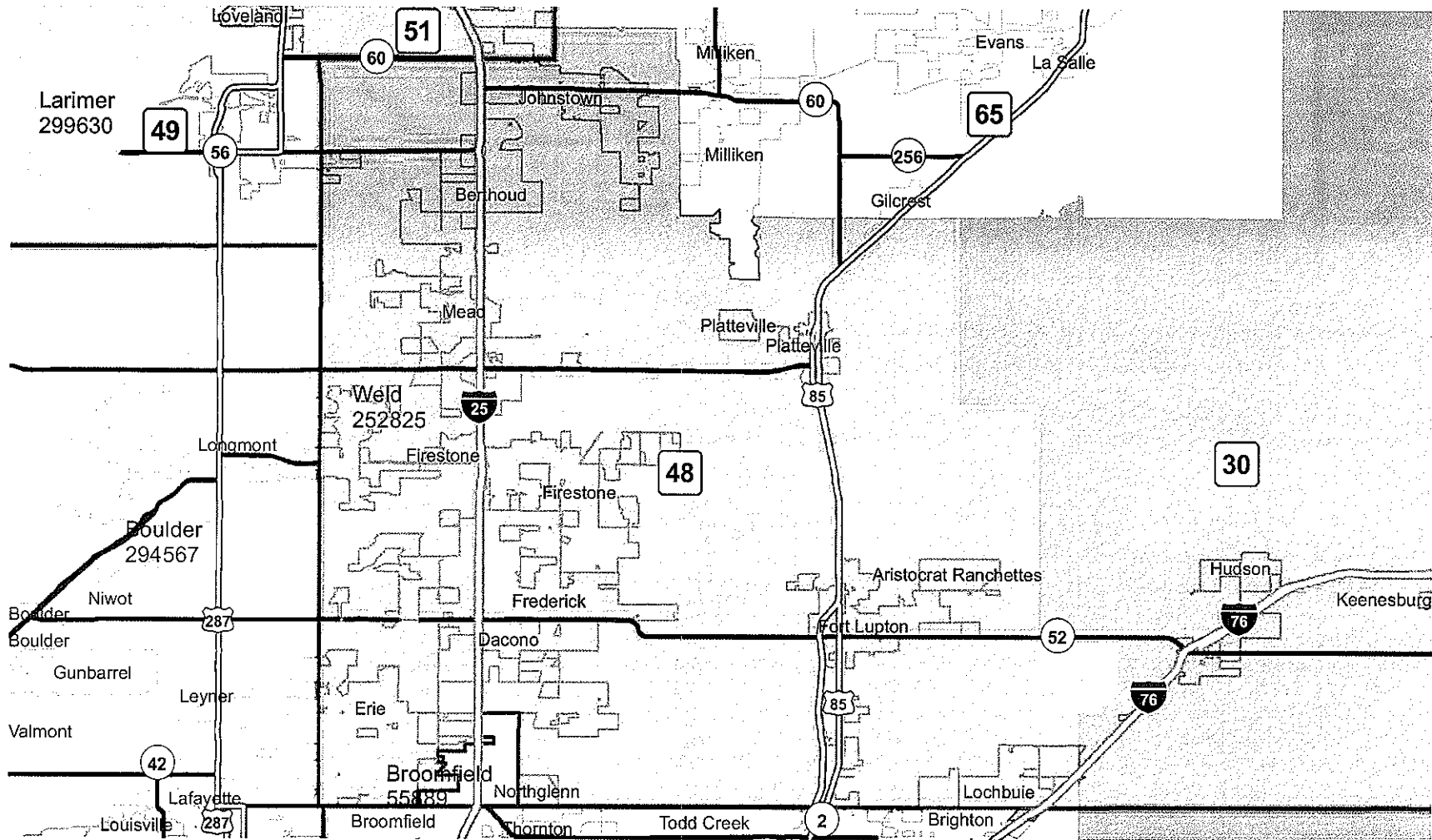

## House District 48 Zoom



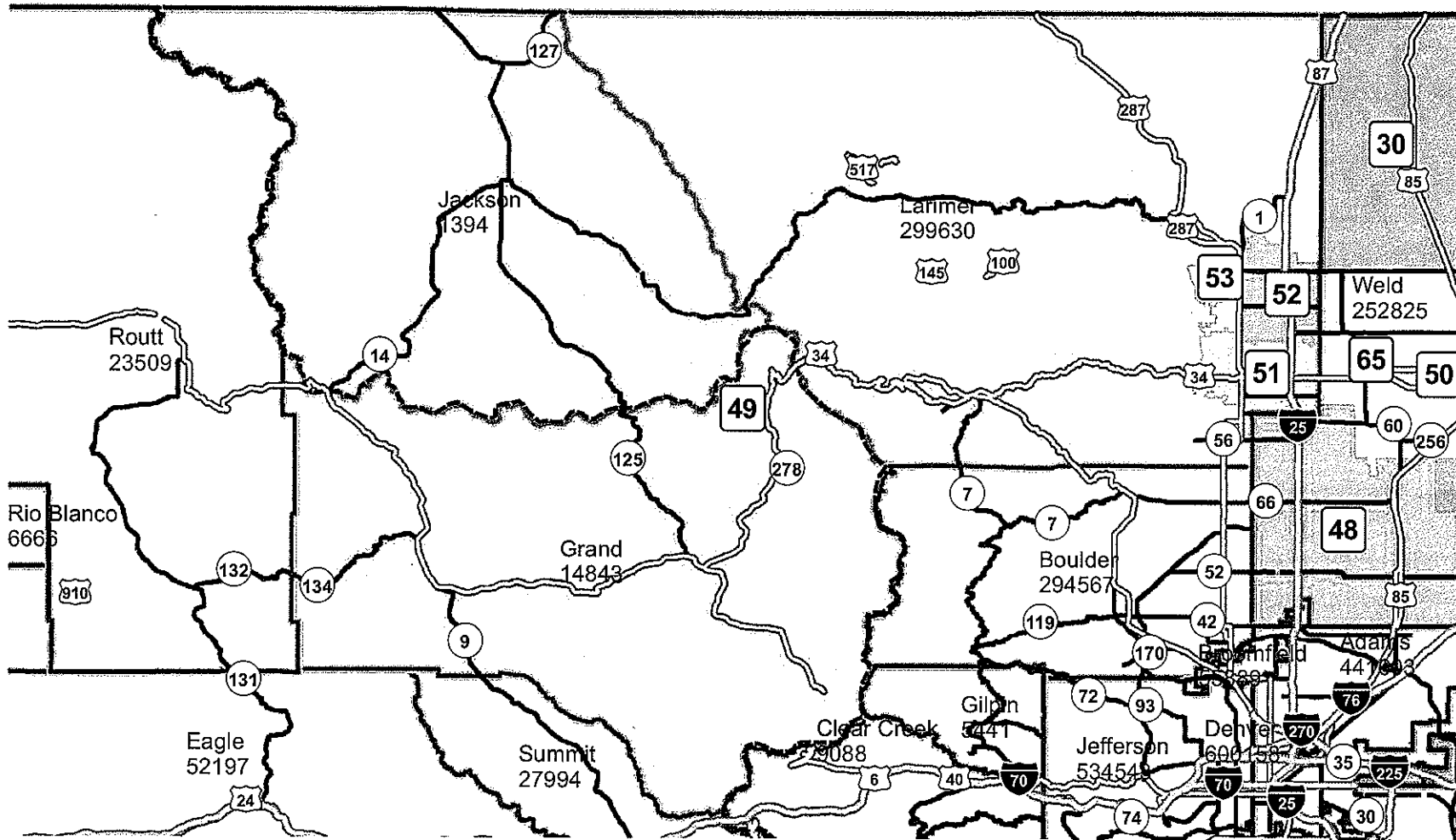

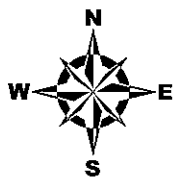

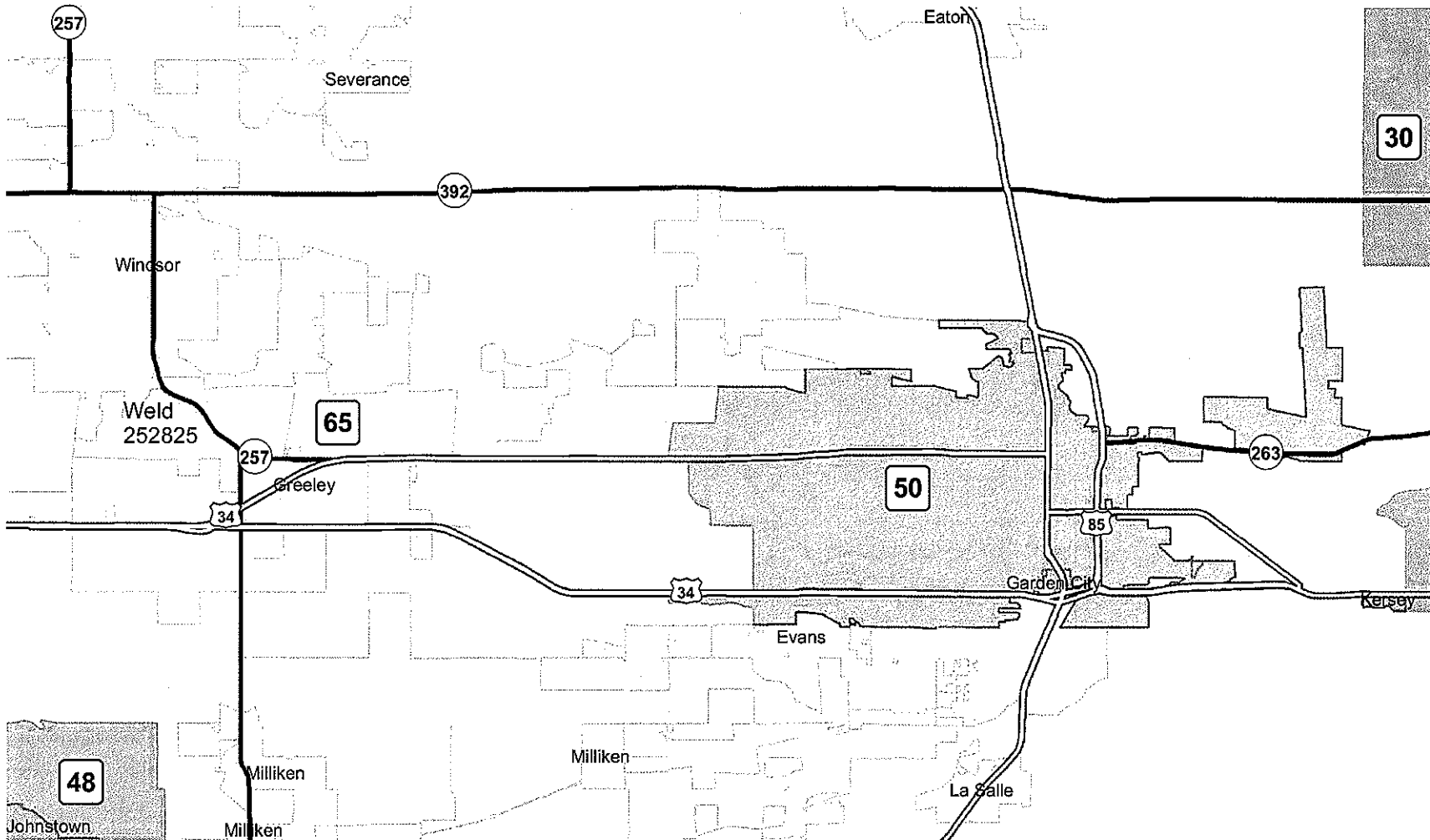

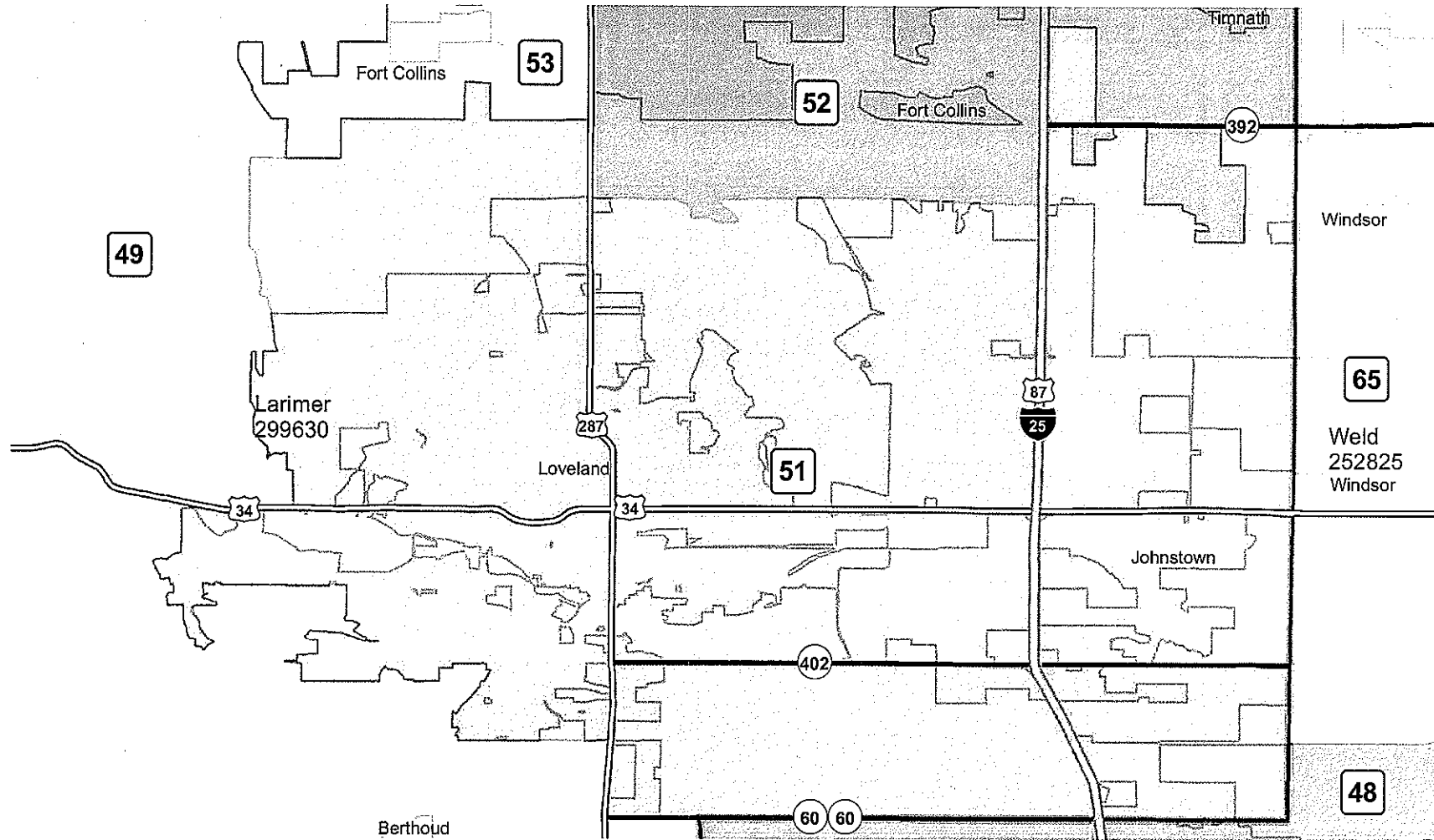

## House District 51 Zoom



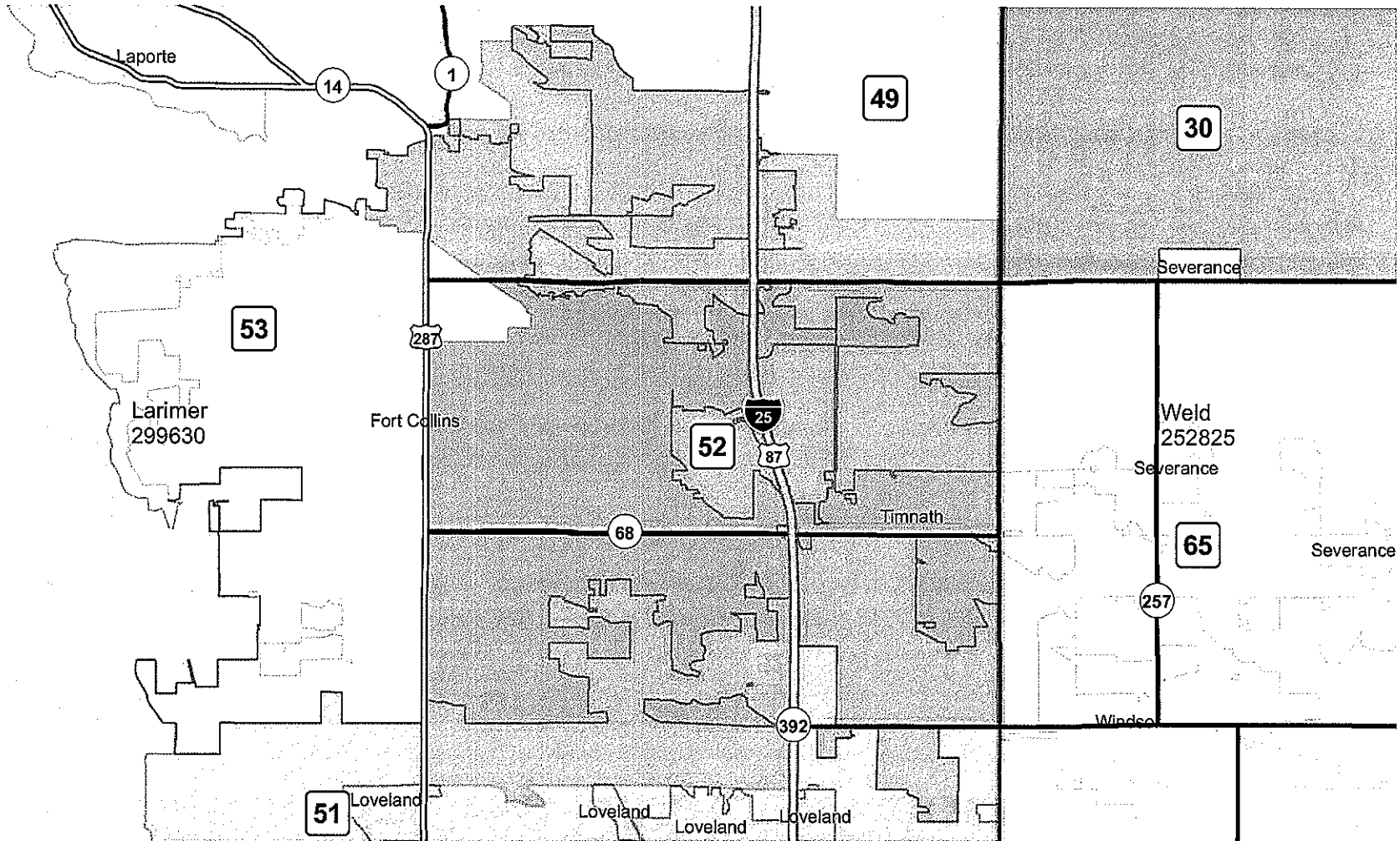
