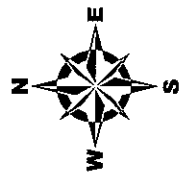


House Plan Region Three - H3004v2

Mesa County Zoom

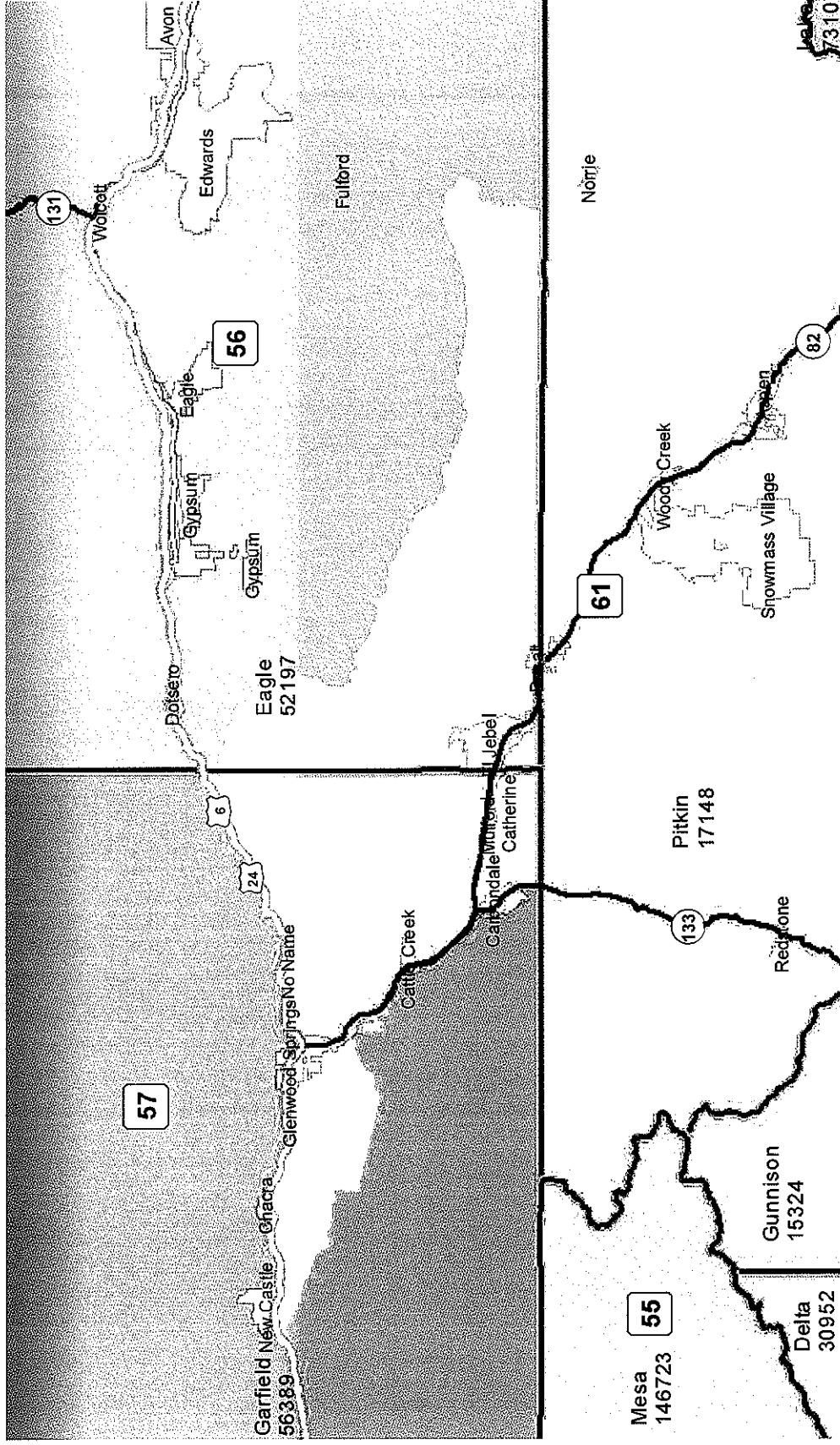

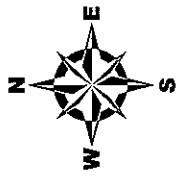


House Plan Region Three - H3004v2

New Castle Zoom

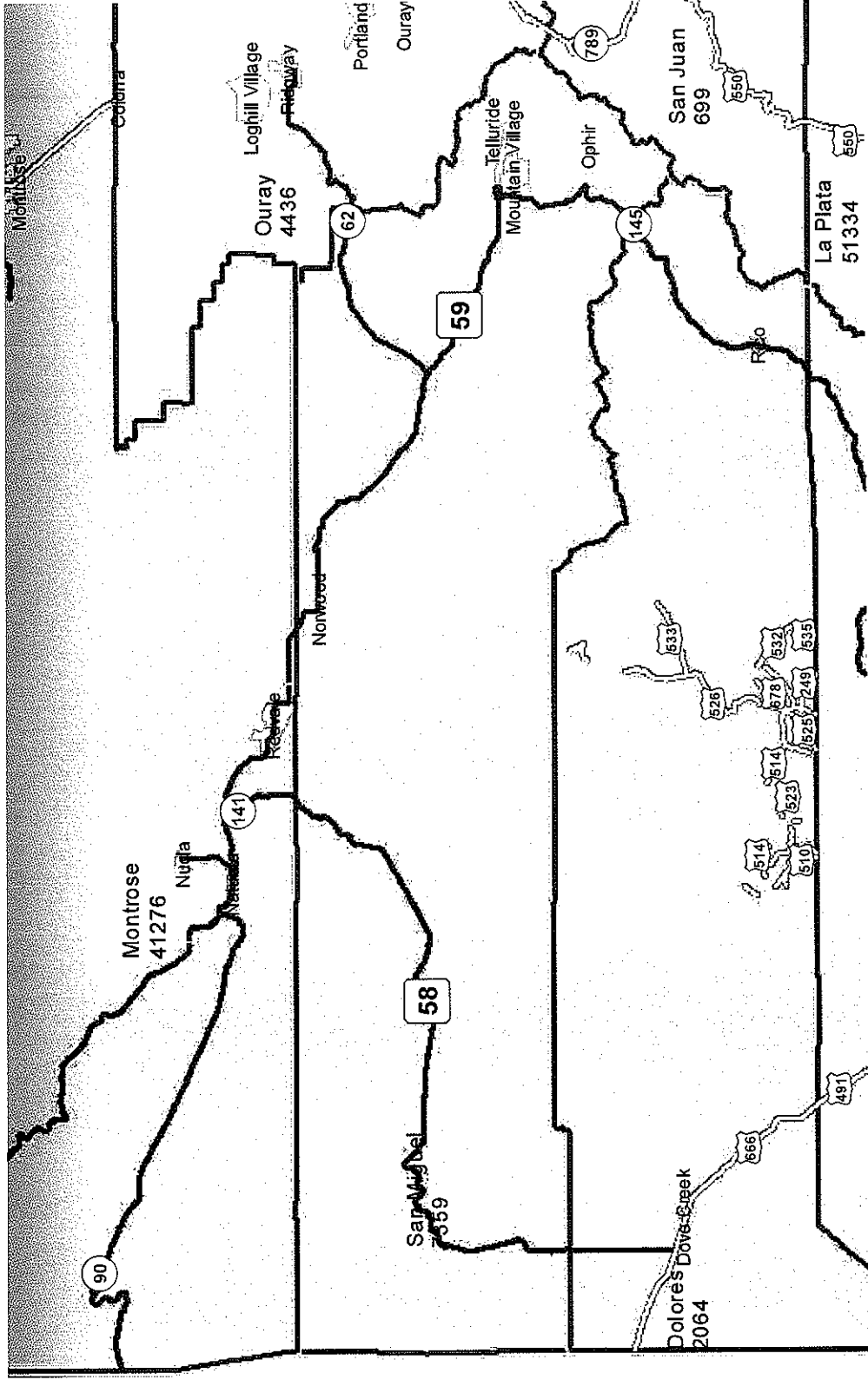
