Staff and Campaign Committee:

The Hon. Hank Brown accepted the position of official campaign chair in January. Shortly thereafter, Colorado Preservation, Inc. retained the services of Hollie Velasquez Horvath, a partner at Onsite Public Affairs, as a strategic advisor to the campaign. Additionally, Arlene Wayland joined the campaign as underwriting executive, and three marketing interns were brought aboard to assist with corporate initiatives; Jeff Rideout, MBA candidate at the Daniels School of Business (DU), Sara Reichert, and Alexander Pritzlaff. The Campaign Committee continues to meet on the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays of each month at CPI's offices at 2100 Downing St., Denver. Recommendations for additional members to serve on the campaign committee are welcome at any time. See campaign committee roster attached.

Seed funding:

A \$50,000 pledge was made to Colorado Preservation, Inc. by AngloGold/Ashanti N.A. on March 17, 2010 for the purposes of funding the marketing consulting retainer paid to Creative Strategies Group, the *Share in the Care Colorado* website and necessary campaign collateral. \$25,000 was paid to CPI in 2010. The second installment of \$25,000 was received in January 2011.

A minimum donation of \$10 is required and all on-line donations are securely process by Community First Foundation and transferred on a monthly basis into the restricted account at Colorado Business Bank. Community First Foundation does not charge an administrative fee for this service.

The 14th annual *Saving Places* Statewide Preservation Conference took place February 2, 3 and 4 at the Embassy Suites Hotel at the Colorado Convention Center. An in-depth presentation about the dome restoration effort was made by the State Architect and representatives from Humphries-Poli Architects at the plenary breakfast on Feb. 3.
