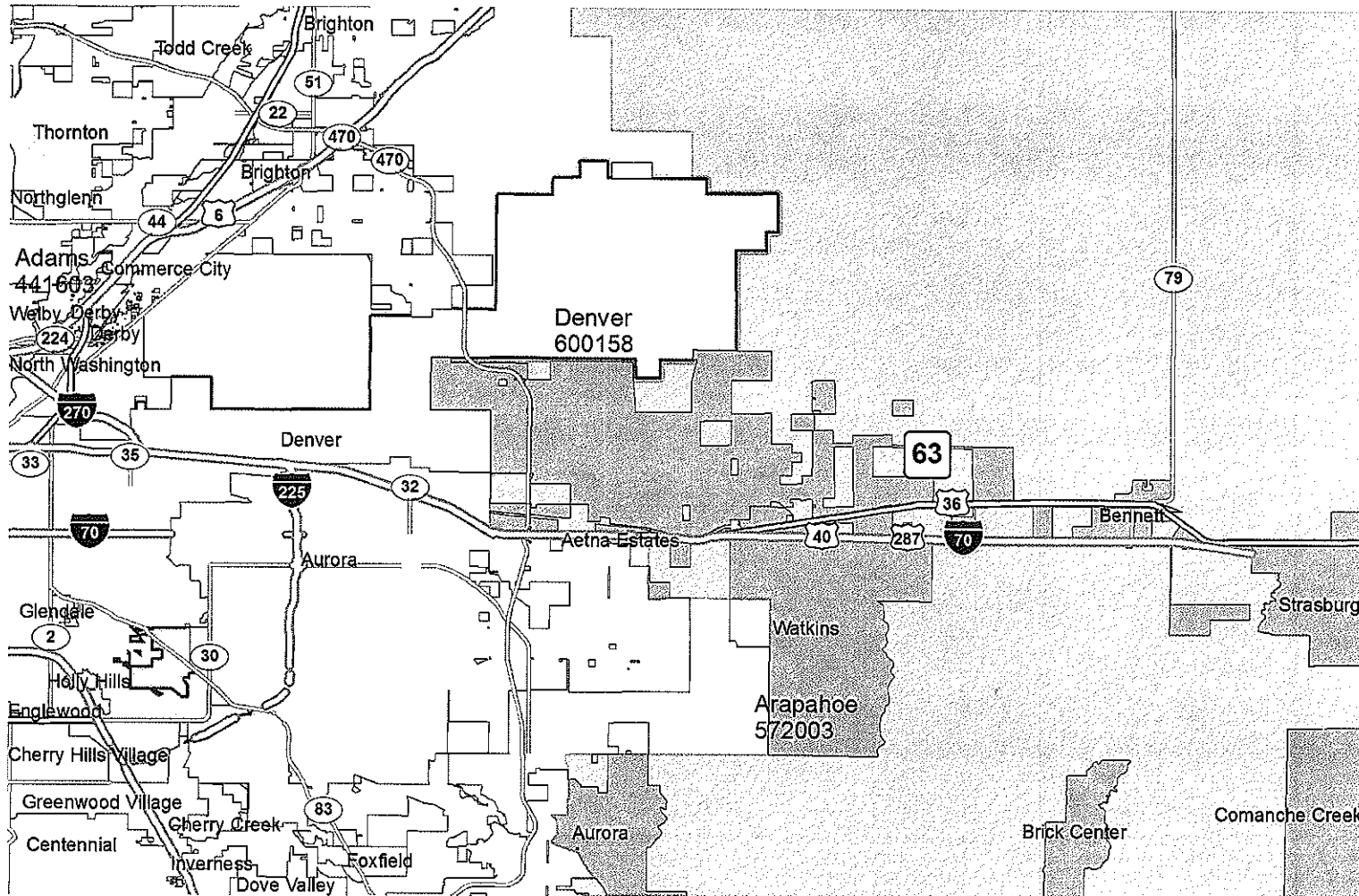
House Region Two Plan - H2003v1 Weld County Zoom



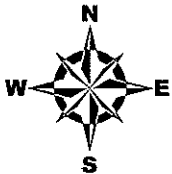
