Consideration of an Amendment to Legislative Council Rule VI

Current Rule VI (2):

Rule VI. Committees - Appointments - Study Resolution

(2) The Council shall meet during the regular session each year not later than April 15 for the purpose of making recommendations, in the form of a joint resolution, of any studies to be conducted during the interim. If the study resolution is not adopted by the end of the regular session, the Executive Committee of the Legislative Council shall determine the interim studies and shall provide for the conduct of such interim studies by resolution adopted by the Executive Committee no later than the first Monday in June.

Proposed Amendments to Rule VI (2):

Rule VI. Committees - Appointments - Study Resolution

- (2) The Council shall meet during the regular session each year not later than April 15 for the purpose of making recommendations, in the form of a joint resolution, of any studies to be conducted during the interim. If the study resolution is not adopted by the end of the regular session, the Executive Committee of the Legislative Council shall determine the interim studies and shall provide for the conduct of such interim studies by resolution adopted by the Executive Committee no later than the first Monday in June.
- (2) IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 2-3-303.3 (2), C.R.S. AND JOINT RULE 24A, THE COUNCIL SHALL SERVE AS A COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF REVIEWING AND PRIORITIZING ALL BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS THAT CREATE OR AUTHORIZE INTERIM STUDIES OR THAT ALLOCATE ADDITIONAL LEGISLATIVE STAFF RESOURCES DURING THE INTERIM. THE COUNCIL SHALL REPORT BILLS OR RESOLUTIONS ORIGINATING IN THE HOUSE OF INTRODUCTION BY THE 93RD LEGISLATIVE DAY. COMMITTEES OF REFERENCE SHALL REPORT BILLS ORIGINATING IN THE OTHER HOUSE TO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL BY THE 107TH DAY.
