FIRST REPORT OF FIRST CONFERENCE COMMITTEE
ON HB11-1254

THIS REPORT AMENDS THE
REREVISED BILL

To the President of the Senate and the
Speaker of the House of Representatives:

Your first conference committee appointed on HB11-1254,
concerning measures to reduce the frequency of bullying in schools, has
met and reports that it has agreed upon the following:

That the House accede to the Senate amendments made to the bill,
as the amendments appear in the rerevised bill, with the following
changes:

Amend rerevised bill, page 8, line 4, strike "MAY INCLUDE:" and substitute
"INCLUDES:".

Page 12, strike line 15 and substitute "SCHOOL DISTRICT IS ENCOURAGED
TO ENSURE THAT ITS POLICY, AT A MINIMUM, INCORPORATES THE
BIENNIAL".

Page 13, line 8, strike "STUDENT," and substitute "STUDENT. BULLYING
IS PROHIBITED AGAINST ANY STUDENT FOR ANY REASON,".

Page 13, strike lines 12 through 17 and substitute "DESCRIBED IN SECTION
22-32-109 (1) (II) (I). THIS DEFINITION IS NOT INTENDED TO INFRINGE
UPON ANY RIGHT GUARANTEED TO ANY PERSON BY THE FIRST AMENDMENT

TO THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION OR TO PREVENT THE EXPRESSION
OF ANY RELIGIOUS, POLITICAL, OR PHILOSOPHICAL VIEWS."

Page 16, line 4, strike "MAY" and substitute "IS ENCOURAGED TO".
