SUBJECT: Medical Marijuana Computer System. CBI Funding. Technical Correction.

For FY 2010-11, the Department of Public Safety, Colorado Bureau of Investigation, received an appropriation of \$92,000 reappropriated funds (\$46,000 from the Department of Public Health Medical Marijuana Program Cash Fund and \$46,000 from the Department of Revenue Medical Marijuana License Cash Fund) in order to complete an interface between the CDPHE Medical Marijuana Registry, the Department of Revenue, and the Colorado Bureau of Investigation's Colorado Crime Information Center (CCIC). The interface is intended to provide information to police officers concerning the appropriate licensing of individuals and retailers in relation to marijuana. The appropriation was provided through a long bill supplemental (S.B. 11-150) in order to comply with the requirements of H.B. 10-1284 (Massey and Summers/Romer and Spence) concerning the regulation of medical marijuana.

The second-year impact of this decision was an appropriation of \$16,000 reappropriated funds (\$8,000 from the Department of Public Health Medical Marijuana Program Cash Fund and \$8,000 from the Department of Revenue Medical Marijuana License Cash Fund). **JBC staff inadvertently did not include the second-year impact appropriation of \$16,000 reappropriated funds to the Department of Public Safety in the FY 2011-12 Long Bill. Staff requests the Committee approve a technical correction and allow staff to increase the appropriation to the Department of Public Safety, Colorado Bureau of Investigation, Colorado Crime Information Center (CCIC), for Information Technology by \$16,000 reappropriated funds.**
