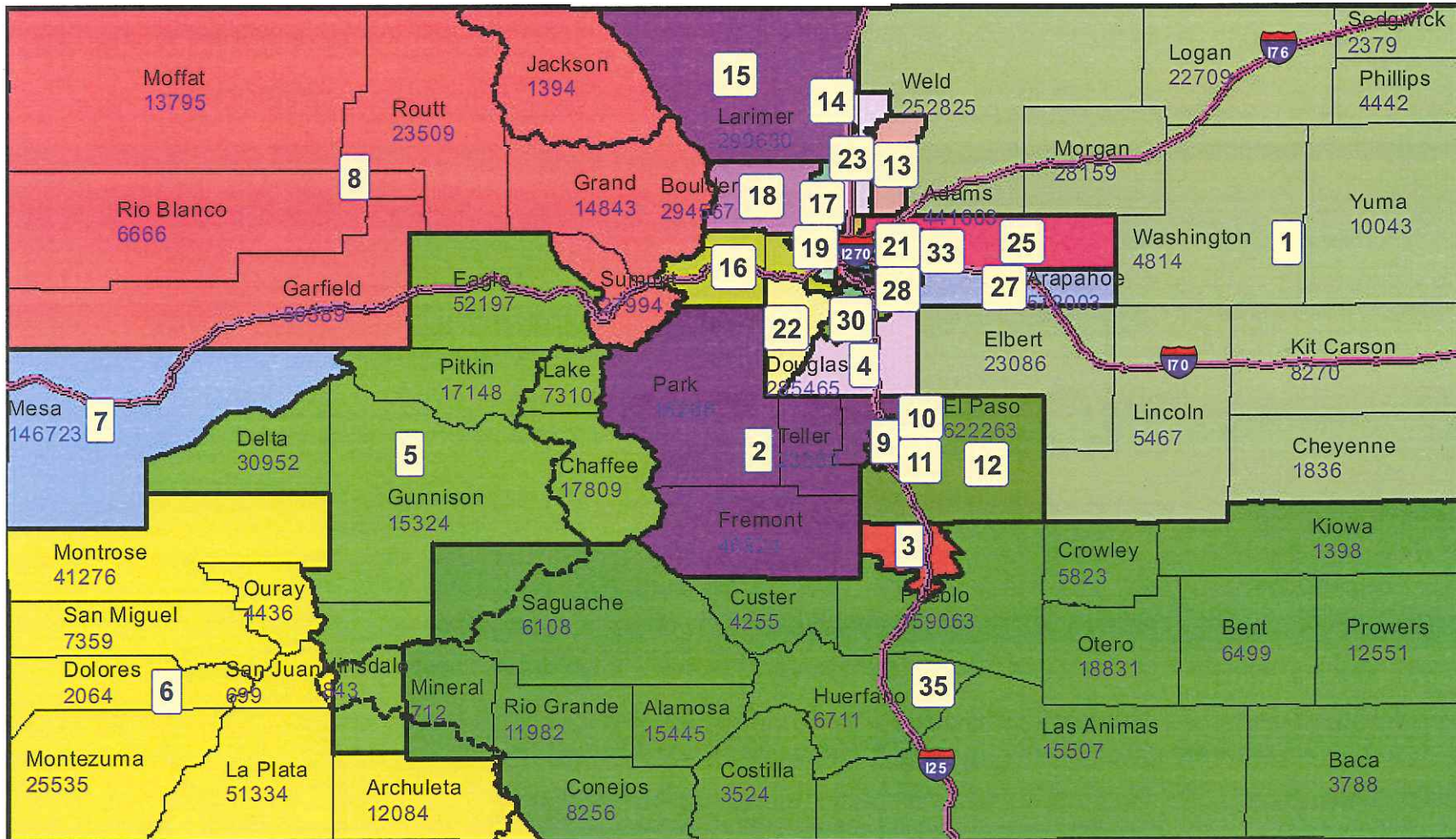

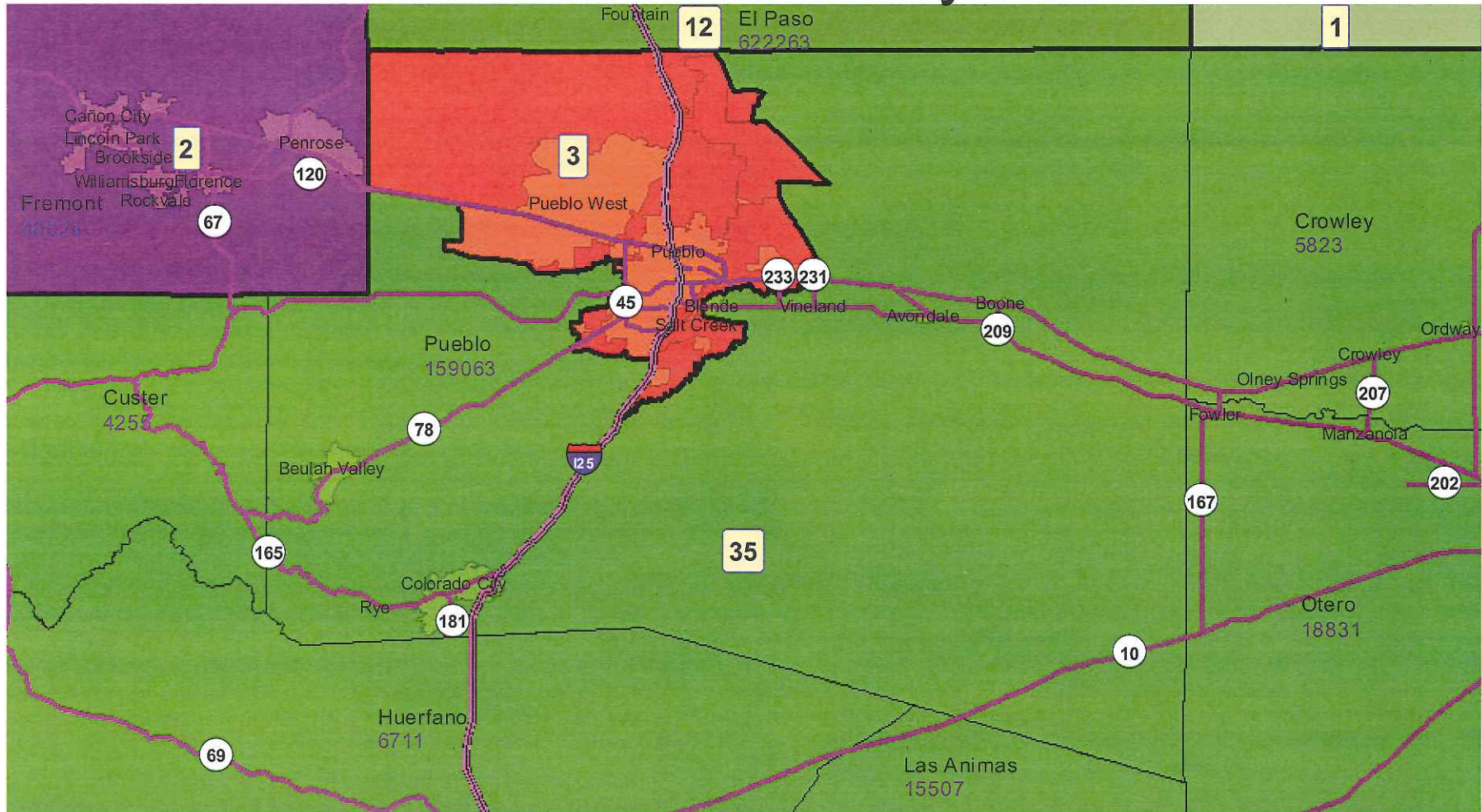

# Senate Resubmitted Plan Cv1 Pueblo County

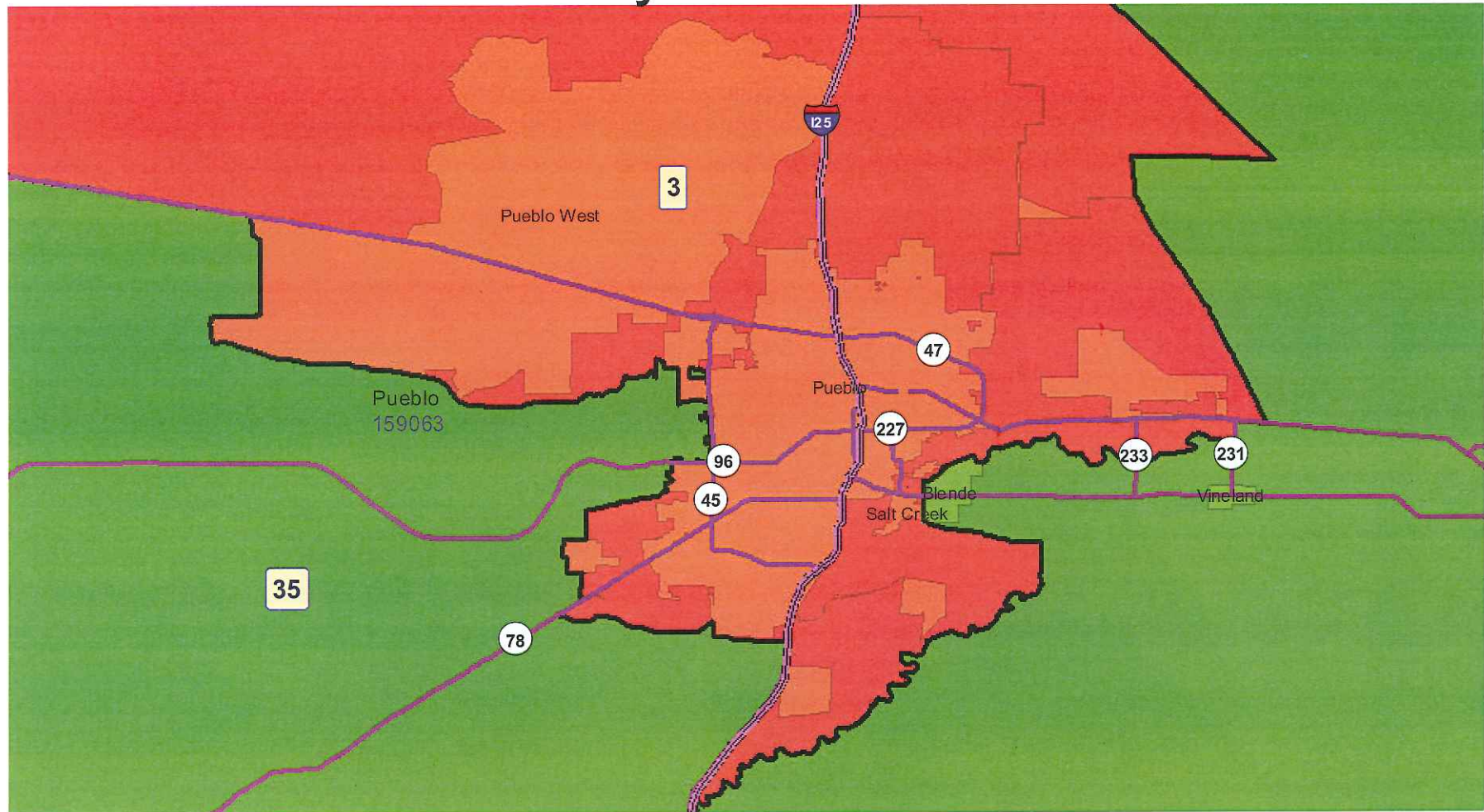

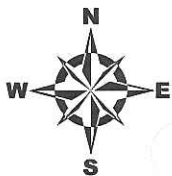




# Senate Resubmitted Plan Cv1 Arapahoe County

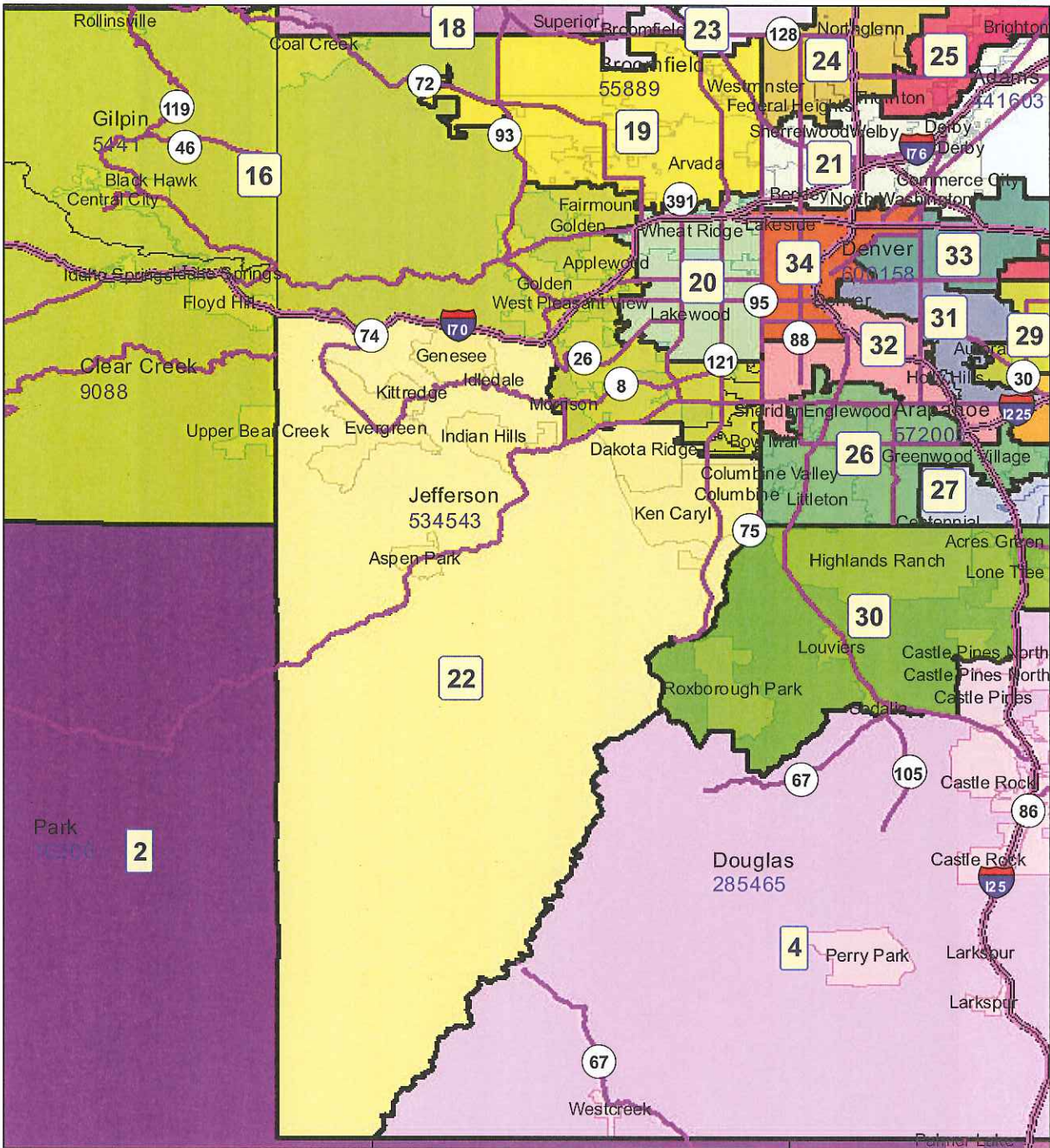

# Senate Resubmitted Plan Cv1 Jefferson County

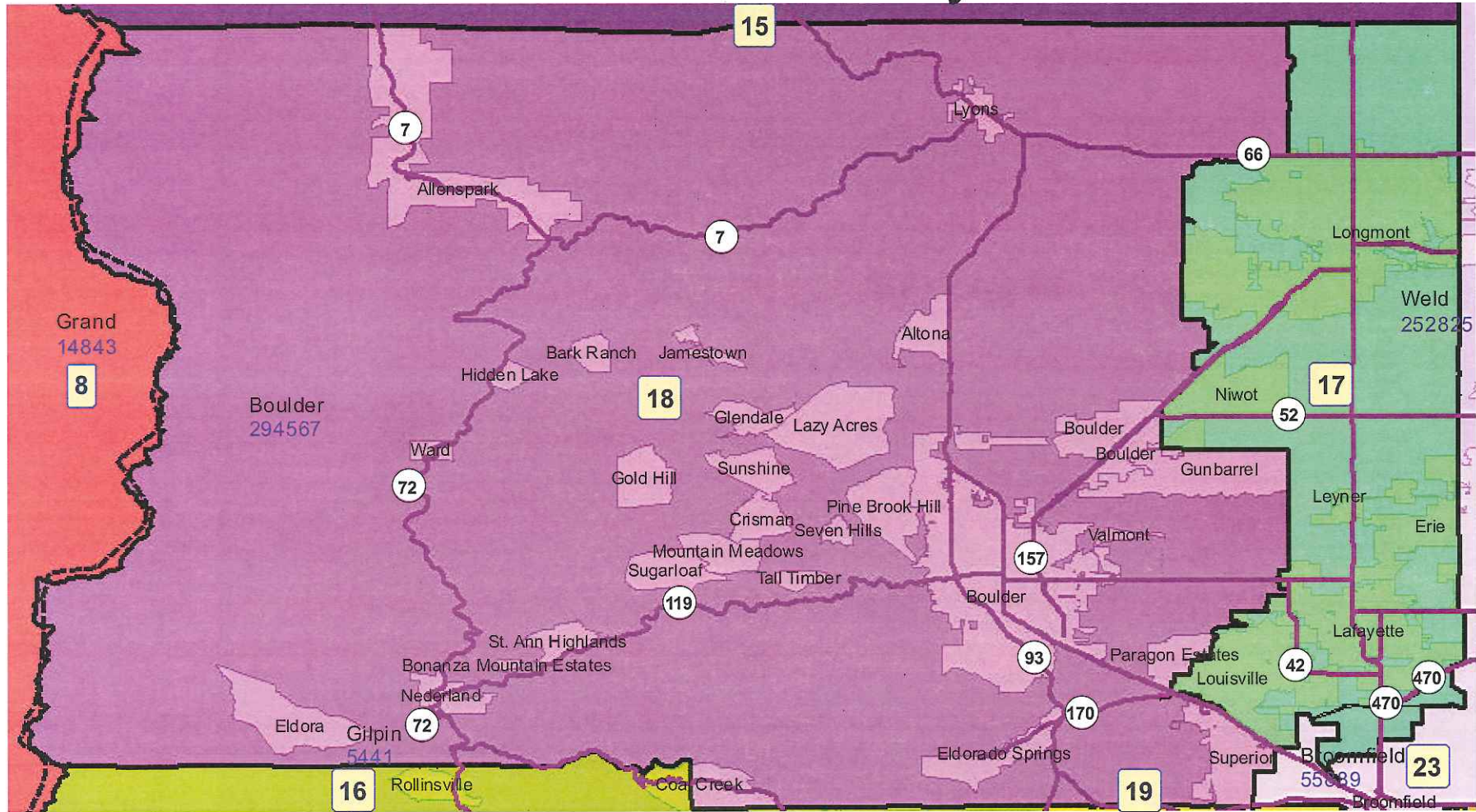
