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Summary of Amendments Made to the Bill After the 02/17/11 Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note Was Prepared (Amended by the Senate Agriculture, Natural Resources and Energy Committee 02/17/11)

The Senate Agriculture, Natural Resources, and Energy Committee Report:

- ▶ Clarifies the requirements for licensure and how a person can seek a review of a licensure denial;
- ▶ Clarifies how an inactive license can be reactivated;
- ▶ Establishes disciplinary actions for persons working with an inactive license;
- ▶ Clarifies that a veterinary student must work under direct supervision of licensed veterinarian;
- ▶ Clarifies the structure of corporations;
- ▶ Clarifies the definition of corporation and veterinary premises;
- ▶ Defines client, complainant, direct supervision, immediate supervision, and animal massage; and,
- ▶ Makes technical changes to the bill.

JBC Staff and Legislative Council Fiscal Note Staff agree that these amendments do not change the bill's fiscal impact.

JBC Staff Concurrence with Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note

Reason for the Update

JBC Staff calculated the appropriation for legal services using the FY 2010-11 blended rate of \$73.37 per hour. The February 17, 2011 Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note incorrectly used an hourly rate of \$73.50.

Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$12,075 cash funds from the Division of Registrations Cash Fund (\$7,673 to the Division of Registrations and \$4,402 to the Executive Director's Office) for FY 2011-12. Amendment J.001 reappropriates \$4,402 to the Department of Law for the provision of legal services.

Bill Sponsor Amendments

Staff is not aware of any sponsor amendments to be offered.
