**WATER POLLUTION CONTROL REVOLVING FUND (WPCRF)**

This document is being provided by the Authority in support of Senate Joint Resolution ("SJR") 12-003. The following narrative briefly outlines the Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund (WPCRF Program) and the procedures used to identify projects, the funding process associated with a loan, and the status of the program.

**PROGRAM SUMMARY**

The WPCRF Program was created in 1988 under Section 37-95-107.6, C.R.S., in response to the Federal Clean Water Act of 1987. The Act converted the existing construction grants program for wastewater facilities to a revolving loan program. The Authority was authorized to fund the State's required 20 percent match and to provide funds for program operation and administration. The legislation also authorized thirty wastewater projects and set up a joint resolution process to make additions or modifications to this initial list. This year SJR 12-003 will add 16 projects, modify 29 projects and delete 7 projects. With the adoption of SJR 12-003, the eligibility list will include 381 projects with an estimated cumulative need of nearly \$3.40 billion.

The projects identified in SJR 12-003 are primarily wastewater treatment facilities. The projects were initially evaluated by the staff of the Water Quality Control Division (WQCD). The projects were then categorized under the Water Quality Control Commission's Regulation No. 51. Eligible categories include: Category 1 – projects that will improve or benefit public health; Category 2 – projects that will utilize proactive and long-range planning of water quality approaches and/or pollution prevention methods (e.g., capacity/growth issues, water reuse, conservation, best management practices for non-point source projects, etc.); and Category 3 – projects that will improve or benefit water quality. The Commission reviews the new projects through an annual public hearing process in October/November.

Upon submittal of an application for assistance by a governmental agency to the WQCD, the Division of Local Government (DLG) initiates a financial analysis of that governmental agency. This analysis includes the review of available revenue sources and a determination of the agency's ability to repay a loan. Based on this analysis, the three agencies act as a committee to either deny the application or forward a positive funding recommendation to the Authority's Board of Directors. The Board makes the final decision on a potential loan.

**PROGRAM STATUS**

In 1989, the Authority's Board of Directors executed the WPCRF Operating Agreement and FY 1989 Capitalization Grant Agreement with the EPA. The Operating Agreement outlines the overall financial program and the procedures for administering the program. Through FY 2011, the Authority has received \$283 million in capitalization grants from EPA. For FY 2012 the Authority expects to receive a grant of \$12 million.

Of the \$283 million received to date, \$9.9 million has been reserved for administration of the WPCRF Program and the remaining \$273.1 million has been reserved for loans. The administrative grant money and loan administrative fees are used to cover the programmatic operating costs of the WQCD, DLG and the Authority. With leveraging, the remaining grant funds, the FY 2012 grant and re-loan funds, the loan capacity for 2012 is estimated at \$35 million.

For each dollar of Federal grant, the Authority must provide a 20 cent match. To date, the Authority has provided \$50.3 million in match. The match has come from Authority loans (\$43.8 million), revenue bonds (\$6.1 million) and other sources (\$0.4 million).

Through December 31, 2011, 210 loans have been executed, representing \$929 million in projects. The Authority anticipates issuing up to \$35 million in loans in 2012.
