Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision decreasing the appropriation to the Department of Public Safety by \$1,852,948 and 26.4 FTE. Of this amount, \$1,546,877 is from the General Fund and \$306,071 is cash funds from concealed handgun application fees.

Bill Sponsor Amendments

Staff is not aware of any sponsor amendments to be offered.

Points to Consider

The General Appropriations Act for FY 2012-13 has not been introduced. The appropriation adjustments in this bill are based on an estimate. Thus, adjustments to the FY 2012-13 General Appropriations Act may be required through the budget true-up process.
