**Amendments/Appropriation Status**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$198,830 and 2.7 FTE to the Department of Personnel for FY 2012-13.

**Bill Sponsor Amendments**

Staff is not aware of any sponsor amendments to be offered.

**Points to Consider**

1. As indicated on page two of the Legislative Council Staff Revised Fiscal Note, the Colorado Department of Transportation anticipates a one-time cost of \$6,488 in FY 2012-13, to be paid from the State Highway Fund that is continuously appropriated.
2. As indicated on page three of the Revised Fiscal Note in the *Departmental Difference* section, staff agrees with the Legislative Council staff assessment of the requirements of the bill and the definition of the term, *manufactured in the United States*, that the Department need not source components of goods for goods with value-added processes that occur in the United States.
