AGRICULTURE, LIVESTOCK, & NATURAL RESOURCES

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB12-1317 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

Amend printed bill, page 2, line 5, after "**plan -**" insert "**legislative declaration -**".

Page 3, line 11, strike "APPOINTMENTS." and substitute "APPOINTMENTS;".

Page 3, strike lines 12 through 14.

Page 3, line 18, strike "AND".

Page 3, line 19, strike "FIVE" and substitute "THREE" and strike "A REASONABLE" and substitute "THAT THEY".

Page 3, line 20, strike "KNOWLEDGE OF WILDLIFE ISSUES AND WHO".

Page 3, after line 25 insert:

"(IV) ONE MEMBER WHO IS AN OUTFITTER REGISTERED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 55.5 OF TITLE 12, C.R.S.; AND

(V) ONE MEMBER WHO REPRESENTS A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT SUPPORTS AND PROMOTES THE CONSERVATION AND ENHANCEMENT OF COLORADO'S WILDLIFE AND HABITAT; RECOGNIZES AND PROMOTES PRIMARILY NONCONSUMPTIVE WILDLIFE USE; AND HAS EXPERTISE IN WILDLIFE ISSUES, WILDLIFE HABITAT, OR WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT."

35 AND ITS VISITORS;

37 (II) A COMPREHENSIVE PROGRAM DESIGNED TO OFFER THE
38 GREATEST POSSIBLE VARIETY OF RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITY TO THE
39 PEOPLE OF THE STATE AND ITS VISITORS IS PROVIDED;

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41 (III) THERE MUST BE A CONTINUOUS OPERATION OF PLANNING,
42 ACQUISITION, DEVELOPMENT, AND MANAGEMENT OF WILDLIFE HABITATS,
43 STATE PARKS, OUTDOOR RECREATION LANDS, TRAILS, WATERS, AND
44 FACILITIES; AND

46 (IV) BOTH EDUCATION AND OUTREACH ACTIVITIES MUST BE USED
47 TO PROMOTE NATURAL RESOURCES STEWARDSHIP.

49 (b) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FURTHER FINDS AND DECLARES THAT
50 THE MISSION OF THE COMMISSION AND THE DIVISION IS TO PERPETUATE
51 THE WILDLIFE RESOURCES OF THE STATE, TO PROVIDE A QUALITY STATE
52 PARKS SYSTEM, AND TO PROVIDE ENJOYABLE AND SUSTAINABLE OUTDOOR
53 RECREATION OPPORTUNITIES THAT EDUCATE AND INSPIRE CURRENT AND
54 FUTURE GENERATIONS TO SERVE AS ACTIVE STEWARDS OF COLORADO'S
55 NATURAL RESOURCES.".
