**THIRD READING OF BILLS -- FINAL PASSAGE**

On third reading, the title of the following bill was publicly read, the reading at length having been dispensed with by unanimous consent:

**HB12S-1002** by Representative(s) Liston and Pabon, Pace; also Senator(s) Jahn--Concerning administration of the unemployment insurance program in order to stabilize unemployment insurance rates, and, in connection therewith, facilitating the issuance of unemployment revenue bonds, accelerating the creation of the division of unemployment insurance in the department of labor and employment, and making technical changes to provisions enacted as part of House Bill 11-1288 to ensure appropriate transition to the new unemployment insurance premium rate structure.

A majority of those elected to the Senate having voted in the affirmative, Senator Jahn was given permission to offer a third reading amendment.

Third Reading Amendment No. 1(L.001), by Senator Jahn.

Amend revised bill, page 12, strike lines 20 through 23 and substitute "DIVISION MAY TRANSFER ANY MONEYS IN THE EMPLOYMENT SUPPORT FUND TO THE UNEMPLOYMENT BOND REPAYMENT ACCOUNT CREATED IN SECTION 8-77-103.5 TO PAY NONPRINCIPAL-RELATED BOND COSTS FOR BONDS ISSUED UNDER SECTION 29-4-710.7, C.R.S., OR SECTION 8-71-103 (2) (d). The employment".
