FIRST REPORT OF FIRST CONFERENCE COMMITTEE ON HB13-1081

To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives:

Your first conference committee appointed on HB13-1081, concerning human sexuality education, has met and reports that it has agreed upon the following:

That the House accede to the Senate amendments made to the bill, as the amendments appear in the rerevised bill, with the following changes:

Amend rerevised bill, page 3, strike lines 13 through 19 and substitute:

"(V) IT IS IMPORTANT FOR YOUTH TO UNDERSTAND THE CONSEQUENCES OF THE INCONSISTENT OR IMPROPER USE OF SEXUAL ABSTINENCE, BIRTH CONTROL, OR CONDOMS. ALL COMPREHENSIVE HUMAN

SEXUALITY EDUCATION MUST STRESS THE IMPORTANCE OF THE CORRECT AND CONSISTENT USE OF SEXUAL ABSTINENCE, BIRTH CONTROL, AND CONDOMS TO PREVENT PREGNANCY AND SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED INFECTIONS;".
