- "(5) (a) The Colorado bureau of investigation shall conduct the chemical testing of the biological substance samples obtained pursuant to this section. The Colorado bureau of investigation shall file and maintain the results thereof and shall furnish the results to a law enforcement agency upon request. The Colorado bureau of investigation shall store and preserve all biological substance samples obtained pursuant to this section.
- 11 (b) If an offender's sample is collected, analyzed, and 12 MAINTAINED BY THE COLORADO BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION BASED 13 SOLELY ON A CLASS 1 MISDEMEANOR CONVICTION PURSUANT TO 14 PARAGRAPH (g) OF SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION, THE COLORADO 15 BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION MAY ONLY FILE AND MAINTAIN THE SAMPLE 16 AND RESULTS AND FURNISH THE RESULTS TO LAW ENFORCEMENT FOR A 17 PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS FROM THE DATE OF THE OFFENDER'S CONVICTION. 18 AFTER THE FIVE-YEAR PERIOD EXPIRES, THE COLORADO BUREAU OF 19 INVESTIGATION SHALL DESTROY THE SAMPLE AND EXPUNGE THE RESULTS 20 OF THE SAMPLE FROM THE FEDERAL COMBINED DNA INDEX SYSTEM AND 21 ANY STATE INDEX SYSTEM. THIS PARAGRAPH (b) SHALL NOT APPLY IF THE 22 PERSON HAS BEEN ARRESTED FOR, CHARGED WITH, OR CONVICTED OF 23 SOME OTHER OFFENSE ON THE BASIS OF WHICH A BIOLOGICAL SUBSTANCE 24 SAMPLE WAS OR COULD HAVE BEEN COLLECTED UNDER STATE STATUTE.".
