Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates \$23,064 cash funds from the Employment Support Fund and 0.3 FTE to the Division of Labor in the Department of Labor and Employment in FY 2013-14.

Points to Consider

Technical Issues

This bill does not specifically create a cash fund for revenues from fines levied on employers. The General Assembly may want to consider amending statute to allow revenues from fines to be credited and expended from the Employment Support Fund for the purposes of this bill.
