

HB 14-1066 County Clerk and Recorder Driver's License Fee Colorado County Clerks Association Fact Sheet

Summary

Currently, a County Clerk and Recorder's Office that issues a driver's license may retain \$8 of the fee. The bill allows the office to retain \$13.60 of the fee in counties of fewer than 100,000 people.

Who

There were 10,940 driver's licenses issued in eleven rural counties. They include Baca, Cheyenne, Kiowa, Kit Carson, Lake, Lincoln, Phillips, Saguache, Sedgwick, Washington and Yuma.

Current Description of Process

County administered driver's license complete various functions related to the issuance of Colorado Driver's Licenses. This may include:

- o Renewals/Issuance - \$20.40 (\$21.00) - (8.00 Retained by county, \$3.40 Driver's Licensing Services Cash Fund and 9.00 HUTF, \$.60 ID security surcharge) - 10 minute transaction (average) for renewals and 60 minutes average on issuance (with drive test)
- o Out of State Driver's License Reissuance - \$20.40 (\$21.00) - (8.00 Retained by county, \$3.40 Driver's Licensing Services Cash Fund and 9.00 HUTF, \$.60 ID security surcharge) - 10 minute transaction
- o CDL Licenses - \$35.00 (\$8.00 Retained by county, \$27.00 to DOR)

Additional Services provided where fees are collected and remitted to DOR, no county retention

- ID issuance - \$10.50 (to DOR)
- Instruction Permits - \$14.00 (to DOR)
- Motor Vehicle Record - \$2.20 (to DOR)

Additional Services provided where no fees are collected for either DOR or the County - Multiple tests may be administered before a passing score allows issuance.

- Drive Tests - N/C
- Written Tests - N/C
- CDL Drive Tests - N/C
- CDL Written Tests - N/C
- Address changes - N/C
- CDL Physical Data Entry Required - N/C

Current Time of Process

The average service time is 25 minutes for Renewal and up to a minimum of 50 minutes for a drive test and issuance of license.

Percentage of out of county transactions

Based on 6 counties responding to a survey, the following percentages of out of county transactions reported were 15%, 28%, 35%, 50%, 60%, and 90%. This creates an average of 46% per location.
