## Fact Sheet for HB 1225

- Cell phone use has grown dramatically in recent years, leading to a substantial increase in use while driving and an increase in distracted-driving related deaths.
- In 1995, only 11% of the U.S. population had a cell phone subscription.
- In 2010, 93% of the population had a subscription.
- Cell phone distractions include:
  - o Talking
  - o Texting
  - o Dialing a number
  - o Using social media
  - o Playing games, music or apps
  - o Surfing the web
  - o Plugging the phone into a charger
  - o General manipulation of the phone
- Approximately 660,000 drivers are using cell phones or other electronic devices at any given moment during daylight hours.
- At any one time, 9% of drivers are talking on cell phones.
- A distracted driver is 4 times more likely to cause an accident.
