HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Local Government.

HB14-1196 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 4, line 15, strike "SEVENTEEN" and substitute
2 "TWENTY-TWO".
- 3 Page 6, line 16, strike "AND".
- 4 Page 6, after line 16 insert:
- 5 "(d) FIVE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE COMMUNITY OF CITIZENS WHO
6 WANT RESPONSIBLE AND REASONABLE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE
7 LEGALIZATION OF RETAIL MARIJUANA AND RETAIL MARIJUANA PRODUCTS
8 AS FOLLOWS:
- 9 (I) ONE REPRESENTATIVE WHO WORKS TO PROTECT THE STATE'S
10 YOUTH FROM EARLY MARIJUANA USE TO BE APPOINTED BY SMART
11 COLORADO;
- 12 (II) ONE REPRESENTATIVE WHO WORKS TO HELP RECOVERING
13 ADDICTS ADJUST TO SOBRIETY THROUGH GROUP SPORTS ACTIVITIES TO BE
14 APPOINTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF PHOENIX MULTISPORT;
- 15 (III) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM A STATE PROGRAM THAT
16 PROVIDES FUNDING FOR LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS THAT WORKS WITH YOUTH
17 AND THEIR FAMILIES TO PREVENT YOUTH CRIME AND VIOLENCE AND CHILD
18 ABUSE AND NEGLECT TO BE APPOINTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE TONY
19 GRAMPSAS YOUTH SERVICES PROGRAM, CREATED IN PART 1 OF ARTICLE
20 6.8 OF TITLE 26, C.R.S.;
- 21 (IV) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF AN INTERFAITH GRASSROOTS
22 ORGANIZATION TO BE APPOINTED BY THE INTERFAITH ALLIANCE OF
23 COLORADO; AND
- 24 (V) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM A DRUG ABUSE RESISTANCE
25 EDUCATION PROGRAM TO BE APPOINTED BY THE COLORADO ASSOCIATION
26 OF D.A.R.E. OFFICERS BOARD; AND".
- 27 Reletter succeeding paragraph accordingly.
