



UCCS Brief Overview

cistablished in 1965, UCCS is located in Colorado Springs on 521 acres at the foot of Austin Bluffs. As a regional comprehensive university, almost 92% of UCCS students originate from Colorado counties. Based on alumni surveys, 60-65% of respondents remain in Colorado Springs after graduation and an additional 10-12% of respondents remain in Colorado. With nearly 40,000 alumni, approximately 24,000 UCCS graduates currently live in Colorado Springs a number that is projected to increase to over 55,000 alumni living in Colorado Springs by 2031.


North Nevada Expansion


Existing Program Space
