HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT Committee on <u>Agriculture</u>, <u>Livestock</u>, & <u>Natural Resources</u>. <u>HB15-1167</u> be amended as follows:

Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and substitute:

3 "SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 37-60-115, add (10) 4 as follows:

37-60-115. Water studies - rules - repeal. (10) South Platte river basin storage study. (a) The Board shall make, or cause to be Made, a study of the feasibility of supplementing water supplies in the South Platte river basin through the construction of one or more new reservoirs in the South Platte river basin and the importation of water into Colorado from the Missouri river basin. The goals of the study are to:

- (I) ASSESS THE SUITABILITY OF STORAGE SITES IN THE SOUTH PLATTE RIVER BASIN, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THEY MAY PREVIOUSLY HAVE BEEN STUDIED, INCLUDING TAMARACK RANCH STATE WILDLIFE AREA AND THE NARROWS PROJECT NEAR FORT MORGAN AS REFERENCED IN PUB.L. 91-389, TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION THAT THE STORED WATER WOULD BE USED:
- (A) FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE SOUTH PLATTE RIVER COMPACT, ARTICLE 65 OF THIS TITLE;
 - (B) TO AUGMENT MUNICIPAL SUPPLIES, INCLUDING BY EXCHANGE;
- (C) AS A SOURCE OF AUGMENTATION SUPPLY FOR JUNIOR GROUNDWATER DIVERTERS, INCLUDING FOR AGRICULTURAL PURPOSES;
- (D) CONJUNCTIVELY WITH GROUNDWATER SUPPLIES, INCLUDING BY STORING WATER IN THE ALLUVIAL AQUIFER; AND
- (E) TO REDUCE THE NEED FOR THE IMPORTATION OF WATER INTO THE SOUTH PLATTE RIVER BASIN FROM OTHER BASINS IN COLORADO, INCLUDING, SPECIFICALLY, THE COLORADO RIVER BASIN;
- (II) ESTIMATE, FOR EACH OF THE PREVIOUS TWENTY YEARS, THE VOLUME OF WATER THAT HAS BEEN DELIVERED TO NEBRASKA IN EXCESS OF THE AMOUNTS REQUIRED TO BE DELIVERED BY THE SOUTH PLATTE RIVER COMPACT, ARTICLE 65 OF THIS TITLE, AND THAT COULD OTHERWISE HAVE BEEN STORED IN THE LOWER SOUTH PLATTE RIVER BASIN;
- 33 (III) ASSESS THE FEASIBILITY OF CONSTRUCTING A NEW RESERVOIR
 34 AT ONE OR MORE OF THE STORAGE SITES STUDIED PURSUANT TO
 35 SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH (a), INCLUDING CONSIDERATION
 36 OF ENVIRONMENTAL, PERMITTING, WATER AVAILABILITY, FINANCIAL, AND
 37 LEGAL CONSTRAINTS, INCLUDING THOSE IMPOSED BY THE SOUTH PLATTE



- RIVER COMPACT AND THE "COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT FOR PLATTE RIVER RESEARCH AND OTHER EFFORTS RELATING TO ENDANGERED SPECIES HABITATS ALONG THE CENTRAL PLATTE RIVER, NEBRASKA"; AND
- (IV) Assess, using existing data and research from studies previously conducted or being conducted in Colorado or other states in the Missouri river basin, the feasibility of constructing a pipeline to import water into Colorado from the Missouri river basin, including an analysis of water availability; consideration of environmental, permitting, water availability, financial, and legal constraints; and an analysis of potential points of diversion, pipeline routes, places and types of use within Colorado, and places of storage within Colorado, including the sites evaluated pursuant to subparagraph (I) of this paragraph (a).
 - (b) THE BOARD SHALL:

- (I) PROVIDE THE WATER RESOURCES REVIEW COMMITTEE CREATED IN SECTION 37-98-102, THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE, THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY'S COMMITTEES OF REFERENCE WITH JURISDICTION OVER NATURAL RESOURCES WITH AN UPDATE CONCERNING THE STUDY BY OCTOBER 31, 2015;
- (II) INCLUDE THE FINDINGS FROM THE STUDY IN THE COLORADO WATER PLAN;
- (III) COMPLETE THE STUDY AS EXPEDITIOUSLY AS PRACTICABLE, BUT IN NO EVENT LATER THAN DECEMBER 31, 2015; AND
- (IV) PROVIDE A REPORT SUMMARIZING THE STUDY TO THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY'S COMMITTEES OF REFERENCE WITH JURISDICTION OVER NATURAL RESOURCES BY FEBRUARY 15, 2016.
- **SECTION 2.** Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.".
