HB1178 L.001

HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT Committee on <u>Agriculture</u>, <u>Livestock</u>, <u>& Natural Resources</u>. <u>HB15-1178</u> be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and 2 substitute:

3 "SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 37-60-121, add (10) 4 as follows:

37-60-121. Colorado water conservation board construction fund - creation of - nature of fund - funds for investigations - contributions - use for augmenting the general fund - funds created - repeal. (10) Emergency dewatering grant program and study - fund - creation - legislative declaration. (a) (I) The General assembly finds and determines that high groundwater levels in the area of Gilcrest, Colorado, are damaging crops and flooding basements and septic systems. To mitigate the damaging high groundwater levels, the water table needs to be lowered immediately to a level that is no longer damaging by means of emergency pumping of wells that are:

- (A) LOCATED WITHIN OR NEAR THE AREA OF GILCREST, COLORADO; AND
  - (B) PERMITTED FOR DEWATERING.
- (II) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FURTHER FINDS AND DETERMINES THAT REAL-TIME DATA COLLECTION AND SUBSEQUENT EVALUATION SHOULD ACCOMPANY THE EMERGENCY PUMPING OF DEWATERING WELLS TO ANALYZE THE EFFECT THAT DEWATERING HAS ON THE GROUNDWATER LEVELS AND THE AQUIFER.
- (III) THEREFORE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS, DETERMINES, AND DECLARES THAT THE STATE OF COLORADO SHOULD FACILITATE THE EMERGENCY PUMPING OF DEWATERING WELLS IN THE AREA OF GILCREST, COLORADO, AND A STUDY OF THE DEWATERING EFFORTS THROUGH THE ESTABLISHMENT AND FUNDING OF A GRANT PROGRAM AND STUDY.
- (b) The emergency dewatering grant account, referred to in this subsection (10) as the "account", is hereby created in the Colorado water conservation board construction fund. For the 2015-16 and 2016-17 fiscal years, the state treasurer shall transfer two hundred fifty thousand dollars from the Colorado water conservation board construction fund to the account for implementation of the emergency dewatering grant program and study created in this subsection (10).
  - (c) (I) THE BOARD, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE STATE ENGINEER,



SHALL EXPEND MONEY FROM THE ACCOUNT TO AWARD GRANTS FOR EMERGENCY PUMPING OF WELLS PERMITTED FOR DEWATERING WITHIN OR NEAR GILCREST, COLORADO. THE BOARD, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE STATE ENGINEER, MAY AWARD GRANTS TO PUBLIC ENTITIES, PRIVATE ENTITIES, AND PRIVATE INDIVIDUALS SEEKING TO IMPLEMENT EMERGENCY PUMPING OF WELLS PERMITTED FOR DEWATERING.

- (II) THE BOARD, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE STATE ENGINEER, SHALL DEVELOP CRITERIA AND GUIDELINES FOR THE GRANT PROGRAM, INCLUDING SELECTION CRITERIA AND GRANTEE REPORTING CRITERIA.
- (III) THE BOARD MAY ACCEPT AND EXPEND GIFTS, GRANTS, AND DONATIONS FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION (10), BUT THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SUBSECTION (10) IS NOT DEPENDENT ON THE RECEIPT OF GIFTS, GRANTS, AND DONATIONS. THE BOARD SHALL TRANSMIT ALL MONEY RECEIVED THROUGH GIFTS, GRANTS, OR DONATIONS TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THEM TO THE ACCOUNT.
- (IV) (A) On an annual basis, the board, in collaboration with the state engineer, shall report to the water resources review committee, created in section 37-98-102, on the progress of the grant program.
- (B) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2017, THE BOARD, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE STATE ENGINEER, SHALL PROVIDE THE WATER RESOURCES REVIEW COMMITTEE WITH A FINAL REPORT ON THE GRANT PROGRAM.
- (C) To assist with the reporting requirements of this subparagraph (IV), the board, in collaboration with the state engineer, shall develop reporting requirements for grantees.
- (d) (I) The board shall enter into a contract with the Colorado water institute, established in section 23-31-801, C.R.S., and referred to in this subsection (10) as the "institute", using existing procurement mechanisms and agreements between the board and the institute, to conduct, oversee, and coordinate all aspects of a study on the effects that dewatering under the grant program has on the water table and aquifer conditions. The board shall commission the study as soon as practicable.
- (II) THE BOARD SHALL FUND THE STUDY FROM MONEY WITHIN THE ACCOUNT AT LEVELS AGREED TO BETWEEN THE BOARD AND THE INSTITUTE.
- (III) THE INSTITUTE SHALL CONDUCT THE STUDY INDEPENDENTLY TO PROVIDE INFORMATION ON:
- 40 (A) THE IMPLEMENTATION OF DEWATERING MEASURES TO MITIGATE ADVERSE IMPACTS IN THE AREAS EXPERIENCING DAMAGING



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1	HIGH GROUNDWATER LEVELS IN AND NEAR GILCREST, COLORADO; AND
2	(B) THE EFFECTS THAT DEWATERING IN AND NEAR GILCREST,
3	COLORADO, HAS ON THE AQUIFER.
4	(IV) On or before October 1, 2017, the institute shall
5	EVALUATE AND REPORT ITS FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS TO THE BOARD
6	AND THE WATER RESOURCES REVIEW COMMITTEE.
7	(e) This subsection (10) is repealed, effective July 1, 2018.
8	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
9	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
10	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.".
