HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Education.HB15-1323 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 17, before line 1 insert:

2 "SECTION 7. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-9-105.5, add
3 (3.3) as follows:

4 **22-9-105.5. State council for educator effectiveness - legislative
5 declaration - membership - duties - recommendations - rules.**

6 (3.3) THE COUNCIL'S RECOMMENDATIONS FOR MEASURES OF STUDENT
7 ACADEMIC GROWTH PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPHS (a) AND (c) OF
8 SUBSECTION (3) OF THIS SECTION MAY INCLUDE THE USE OF STATE
9 ASSESSMENT RESULTS AS A MEASURE OF STUDENT ACADEMIC GROWTH
10 ONLY IF A LOCAL BOARD RECEIVES THE STATE ASSESSMENT RESULTS FOR
11 A SCHOOL YEAR IN TIME TO TAKE THEM INTO ACCOUNT IN COMPLETING
12 THE EDUCATOR EVALUATIONS FOR THAT SCHOOL YEAR.

13 **SECTION 8.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-9-106, amend
14 (2.5) (b) (II) (A) and add (1.3) as follows:

15 **22-9-106. Local boards of education - duties - performance
16 evaluation system - compliance - rules - repeal.** (1.3) A LOCAL BOARD
17 MAY USE STATE ASSESSMENT RESULTS AS A MEASURE OF STUDENT
18 ACADEMIC GROWTH PURSUANT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF PARAGRAPH (e)
19 OF SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION ONLY IF THE LOCAL BOARD RECEIVES
20 THE STATE ASSESSMENT RESULTS FOR A SCHOOL YEAR IN TIME TO TAKE
21 THEM INTO ACCOUNT IN COMPLETING THE EDUCATOR EVALUATIONS FOR
22 THAT SCHOOL YEAR.

23 (2.5) (b) (II) (A) For the 2014-15 academic year and every year
24 thereafter, a local board shall implement a licensed personnel evaluation
25 system based on the quality standards established pursuant to this article
26 and rule of the state board, including student academic growth; except
27 that, for the 2014-15 academic year only, a local board may determine at
28 what percentage, if any, to weigh student academic growth toward the
29 final level of effectiveness assigned to any person receiving an evaluation
30 pursuant to this article. In no instance may a local board weigh student
31 academic growth, as used in determining a final level of effectiveness, at
32 greater than fifty percent. FOR THE 2014-15 ACADEMIC YEAR, A LOCAL
33 BOARD SHALL NOT USE THE RESULTS OF THE STATE ASSESSMENTS
34 ADMINISTERED PURSUANT TO SECTION 22-7-1006.3 IN MEASURING
35 STUDENT ACADEMIC GROWTH FOR PURPOSES OF DETERMINING A PERSON'S
36 LEVEL OF EFFECTIVENESS."
