HB15-1003 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 5 through 23 and substitute:
- 2 "(3.5) (b) (I) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (a) of this
- 3 subsection (3.5), for the state fiscal year YEARS commencing July 1, 2014,
- 4 AND JULY 1, 2015, all of the grants awarded must be for noninfrastructure programs.
  - (II) This paragraph (b) is repealed, effective July 1, 2015 JULY 1, 2018.
  - (5) (a) For the fiscal year YEARS commencing July 1, 2014, AND JULY 1, 2015, if the state receives federal moneys for the safe routes to school program, the state general fund appropriation for the program is reduced by the amount of the federal moneys received.
- 12 (b) This subsection (5) is repealed, effective July 1, 2015 JULY 1, 2018.
- SECTION 2. Appropriation. For the 2015-16 state fiscal year, \$750,000 is appropriated to the department of transportation. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation to make grants under the safe routes to school program. Any moneys appropriated in this section not expended prior to July 1, 2016, are further appropriated to the department for the 2016-17 and 2017-18 state fiscal years for the same purpose.".
- 21 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
