 - 42-1-228. Revocation hearings right of driver to challenge validity of initial traffic stop. In any administrative proceeding for a revocation of a driver's license pursuant to article 2 of this title, where the
- hearing officer is engaged in finding facts and applying law for an
- incident or offense reported directly to the department by a law enforcement officer, and where the revocation was not triggered in whole
- or in part by a record of a conviction, the driver may challenge the
- validity of the law enforcement officer's initial contact with the driver and
- 21 subsequent arrest of the driver. The hearing officer shall consider such
- 22 issues when a driver raises them as defenses. If A DRIVER SO CHALLENGES
- 23 THE VALIDITY OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER'S INITIAL CONTACT,
- 24 AND THE EVIDENCE DOES NOT ESTABLISH THAT THE INITIAL CONTACT OR
- 25 ARREST WAS CONSTITUTIONALLY AND STATUTORILY VALID, THE DRIVER
- 26 IS NOT SUBJECT TO LICENSE REVOCATION.".
