HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Finance.HB15-1206 be amended as follows:

- 1 Strike the Business Affairs and Labor Committee Report, dated February
2 19, 2015, and substitute:
- 3 "Amend printed bill, page 3, lines 5 and 6, strike "**Refund for recycling**
4 **or reprocessing of waste products**" and substitute "**Exemption for**
5 **waste reduction or recycling equipment**".
- 6 Page 3, line 8, strike "ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF RECYCLING OR".
- 7 Page 3, strike lines 9 through 27.
- 8 Strike page 4.
- 9 Page 5, strike lines 1 through 12 and substitute "THAT OPERATES A
10 RECYCLING FACILITY OR A COMPOSTING FACILITY THAT IS REGISTERED
11 WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT IN
12 CONNECTION WITH THE DEPARTMENT'S ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED PURSUANT
13 TO SECTION 30-20-122 (1) (a) (V), C.R.S., IS EXEMPT FROM ALL STATE
14 SALES AND USE TAXES LEVIED PURSUANT TO PARTS 1 AND 2 OF THIS
15 ARTICLE UPON THE STORAGE, USE, CONSUMPTION, RENTAL, OR SALE OF
16 ANY WASTE REDUCTION OR RECYCLING EQUIPMENT.
- 17 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, UNLESS THE CONTEXT OTHERWISE
18 REQUIRES:
- 19 (a) "MOTOR VEHICLE" MEANS A VEHICLE AS DEFINED IN SECTION
20 42-1-102 (58), C.R.S.
- 21 (b) "RECOVERED MATERIALS" MEANS THOSE MATERIALS THAT
22 HAVE BEEN SEPARATED, DIVERTED, OR REMOVED FROM THE WASTE
23 STREAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECYCLING.
- 24 (c) (I) "RECYCLING" MEANS ANY PROCESS BY WHICH WASTE OR
25 MATERIALS THAT WOULD OTHERWISE BECOME WASTE ARE COLLECTED,
26 SEPARATED, OR PROCESSED AND REVISED OR RETURNED FOR USE IN THE
27 FORM OF RAW MATERIALS OR PRODUCTS, INCLUDING COMPOSTING.
- 28 (II) "RECYCLING" DOES NOT MEAN:
- 29 (A) ANY FORM OF ENERGY REPROCESSING OR ENERGY RECYCLING;
30 (B) THE USE OR PRODUCTION OF ALTERNATIVE DAILY COVER USED
31 AT A LANDFILL SITE;
- 32 (C) THE BENEFICIAL USE OF SOLID WASTES, INCLUDING THE
33 PROCESSING OF BIOSOLIDS AND ACTIVITIES REGULATED UNDER SECTION

2 (D) WASTE GREASE RECYCLING;

3 (E) WASTE TIRE COLLECTION OR PROCESSING;

4 (F) RECYCLING HAZARDOUS WASTE AND HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS

5 WASTE;

6 (G) INDUSTRIAL RECYCLING OPERATIONS.

7 (d) "SOLID WASTE" MEANS ALL PUTRESCIBLE AND

8 NONPUTRESCIBLE WASTES IN SOLID OR SEMISOLID FORM, INCLUDING, BUT

9 NOT LIMITED TO, YARD OR FOOD WASTE, WASTE GLASS, WASTE METALS,

10 WASTE PLASTICS, WASTE PAPERS, WASTE PAPERBOARD, AND ALL OTHER

11 SOLID OR SEMISOLID WASTES RESULTING FROM INDUSTRIAL, COMMERCIAL,

12 AGRICULTURAL, COMMUNITY, AND RESIDENTIAL ACTIVITIES.

13 (e) (I) "WASTE REDUCTION OR RECYCLING EQUIPMENT" MEANS

14 NEW OR USED MACHINERY OR EQUIPMENT THAT IS OPERATED OR USED

15 EXCLUSIVELY IN THE STATE TO COLLECT, SEPARATE, PROCESS, MODIFY,

16 CONVERT, OR TREAT SOLID WASTE SO THAT THE RESULTING PRODUCT MAY

17 BE USED AS A RAW MATERIAL OR FOR PRODUCTIVE USE OR TO

18 MANUFACTURE PRODUCTS CONTAINING RECOVERED MATERIALS. "WASTE

19 REDUCTION OR RECYCLING EQUIPMENT" INCLUDES DEVICES THAT ARE

20 DIRECTLY CONNECTED WITH OR ARE AN INTEGRAL AND NECESSARY PART

21 OF SUCH MACHINERY OR EQUIPMENT AND ARE NECESSARY FOR SUCH

22 COLLECTION, SEPARATION, PROCESSING, MODIFICATION, CONVERSION, OR

23 TREATMENT.

24 (II) "WASTE REDUCTION OR RECYCLING EQUIPMENT" DOES NOT

25 INCLUDE MOTOR VEHICLES."
