 - (B) SHALL NOT BE SOLD, SERVED, GIVEN TO, DISPOSED OF, EXCHANGED, OR DELIVERED TO OR FOR ANY PERSON UNDER TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE.
 - (II) AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION (6), "POWDERED ALCOHOL" MEANS ALCOHOL THAT IS PREPARED OR SOLD IN A POWDER FORM FOR EITHER DIRECT USE OR RECONSTITUTION.
- 24 (b) This subsection (6) takes effect only if the federal 25 Alcohol and tobacco tax and trade bureau approves the use, 26 Purchase, sale, or possession of powdered alcohol in the United 27 States. The executive director of the department of revenue 28 Shall notify the revisor of statutes, in writing, if the condition
- 29 SPECIFIED IN THIS PARAGRAPH (b) OCCURS.".".
