

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Based on §24-4-103 (8), C.R.S., a rule review cycle runs from November 1 to November 1 and the rules adopted or amended during that one-year period automatically expire on the following May 15, unless extended by the General Assembly through the annual Rule Review Bill. An out-of-cycle rule means a rule that is not within the current rule review cycle. Because an out-of-cycle rule is not subject to the statutory automatic expiration, if the COLS decides that an out-of-cycle rule is in conflict with statute or lacks or exceeds statutory authority, the action that the COLS takes is to repeal the rule.
