- 1) Chapter 18 and 19 need to be read and vocabulary explained
- 2) Must know the duration and checkpoints of the menstrual cycle and ovulation as well as the path the ova travels from start to finish
- 3) Needs to know the path sperm cells travel
- 4) Difference between sperm cells and ova and how they are stored/created
- 5) Men vs Women - fertility
- 6) External male genitalia vocab and definitions for the diagram - Including 3 parts of sperm, three parts of the penis, circumcision, and foreskin and glans penis
- 7) External female genitalia vocab and definitions and what they do for the diagram - including mammary glands, labia majora, labia minora, clitoris
- 8) Pregnancy only possible via vaginal intercourse and/or vaginal contact with semen
- 9) STI's transmitted via any other exchange of bodily fluid i.e. blood, semen, vaginal secretions, skin to skin contact, ect.
- 10) Sexual contact not limited to vaginal intercourse- but via oral, mutual manual stimulation (skin to skin contact), and anal intercourse
- 11) Mental, Emotional, and Social - Possible consequences of sexual activity
- 12) Add "Crabs" to STI packet - these are body lice in the pubic region, cured with special shampoo

13) Pay Special attention to Viral infections vs Bacterial infections - student should be able to recognize the difference between the two by name and how they are treated and or cured.

14) Care of and common problems with the Female Reproductive system - including demonstration of breast self-examinations and breast cancer awareness

15) Care of and Common Problems with the Male Reproductive system - including testicular (no demonstration) self-examination and testicular and prostate cancer awareness
