HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Education.

HB15-1273 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 4, line 1, strike "and" and strike "(IX)" and  
2 substitute "(IX), and (11)".

3 Page 4, line 5, strike "**definitions.**" and substitute "**definitions - repeal.**".

4 Page 8, after line 21 insert:

5 "(11) (a) **Review of reporting requirements.** DURING THE 2020  
6 REGULAR LEGISLATIVE SESSION, THE EDUCATION AND JUDICIARY  
7 COMMITTEES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE, OR  
8 ANY SUCCESSOR COMMITTEES, ARE ENCOURAGED TO FORMALLY REVIEW  
9 THE REPORTS RECEIVED FROM THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE  
10 PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-33.5-503 (1) (bb), C.R.S. THE COMMITTEE  
11 MEMBERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO CONSIDER WHETHER TO:

12 (I) CONTINUE TO REQUIRE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AND  
13 DISTRICT ATTORNEYS TO SUBMIT DATA TO THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL  
14 JUSTICE; OR

15 (II) INTRODUCE LEGISLATION TO REPEAL SUCH REPORTING  
16 REQUIREMENTS.

17 (b) THIS SUBSECTION (11) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020."

18 Strike pages 13 and 14 and substitute:

19 "**SECTION 6.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-2-1201, **repeal** (8).

20 **SECTION 7.** In Session Laws of Colorado 2012, **repeal** section  
21 21 of chapter 188.

22 **SECTION 8.** In Session Laws of Colorado 2012, **repeal** section  
23 46 of chapter 188.

24 **SECTION 9. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
25 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
26 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety."
