- 15 (D) DURING EMERGENCY CONDITIONS DECLARED BY THE PROPER STATE OR LOCAL AUTHORITY;
- 17 (E) When using an off-highway vehicle for agricultural 18 purposes;
- (G) When a public utility, as defined in section 40-1-103 (1), C.R.S., or a cooperative electric association, as defined in section 40-9.5-102, C.R.S., or any agent of their entity designated specifically for the purpose of meter reading or repair, is using an off-highway vehicle for business purposes."
