HB15-1286 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, strike lines 1 through 23 and substitute:

2	"(2) THE JUDGE OF A COURT HAVING JURISDICTION OF AN ALLEGED
3	OFFENSE INVOLVING THE INTENTIONAL OR RECKLESS MISCONDUCT BY A
4	PEACE OFFICER ACTING WITHIN THE SCOPE OF HIS OR HER EMPLOYMENT
5	RESULTING IN THE SERIOUS BODILY INJURY TO ANOTHER PERSON OR DEATH
6	OF ANOTHER PERSON, UPON AFFIDAVIT FILED WITH THE JUDGE ALLEGING
7	THE COMMISSION OF A CRIME AND THE UNJUSTIFIED REFUSAL OF THE
8	PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TO PROSECUTE A PEACE OFFICER FOR THE CRIME,
9	MAY REQUIRE THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TO APPEAR BEFORE THE JUDGE
10	AND EXPLAIN THE REFUSAL. THE JUDGE OF A COURT HAVING JURISDICTION
11	OF THE ALLEGED OFFENSE, UPON AFFIDAVIT FILED WITH THE JUDGE
12	ALLEGING THE COMMISSION OF A CRIME AND THE UNJUSTIFIED REFUSAL OF
13	THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TO PROSECUTE ANY PERSON FOR THE CRIME,
14	MAY REQUIRE THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TO APPEAR BEFORE THE JUDGE
15	AND EXPLAIN THE REFUSAL. IF AFTER THAT PROCEEDING, BASED ON THE
16	COMPETENT EVIDENCE IN THE AFFIDAVIT, THE EXPLANATION OF THE
17	PROSECUTING ATTORNEY, AND ANY ARGUMENT OF THE PARTIES, THE
18	JUDGE FINDS THAT THE REFUSAL OF THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TO
19	PROSECUTE WAS ARBITRARY OR CAPRICIOUS AND WITHOUT REASONABLE
20	EXCUSE, THE JUDGE MAY ORDER THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TO FILE AN
21	INFORMATION AND PROSECUTE THE CASE OR MAY APPOINT A SPECIAL
22	PROSECUTOR TO DO SO. THE JUDGE SHALL APPOINT THE SPECIAL
23	PROSECUTOR FROM AMONG THE FULL-TIME DISTRICT ATTORNEYS,
24	ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEYS, OR DEPUTY DISTRICT ATTORNEYS WHO
25	SERVE IN JUDICIAL DISTRICTS OTHER THAN WHERE THE APPOINTMENT IS
26	MADE; EXCEPT THAT, UPON THE WRITTEN APPROVAL OF THE CHIEF JUSTICE
27	OF THE SUPREME COURT, THE JUDGE MAY APPOINT ANY DISINTERESTED
28	PRIVATE ATTORNEY WHO IS LICENSED TO PRACTICE LAW IN THE STATE OF
29	COLORADO TO SERVE AS THE SPECIAL PROSECUTOR. ANY SPECIAL
30	PROSECUTOR APPOINTED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE
31	COMPENSATED AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 20-1-308, C.R.S.
