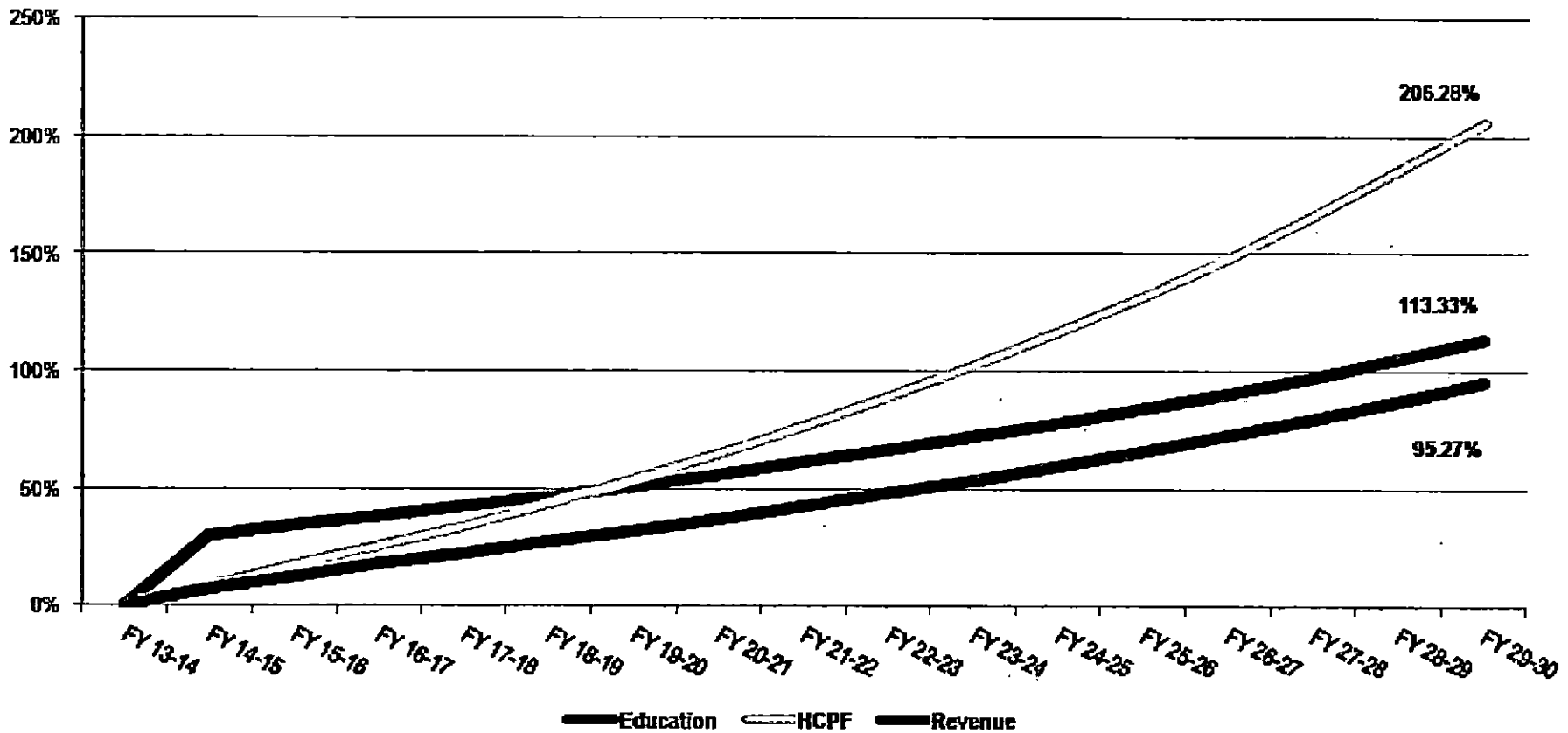


# The Demographic Shift will Impact our Society

- **Workforce**
  - More retirees
  - More older workers
  - Impact of caregiving on workforce
- **Tax base**
  - Less tax base
  - More retirees
  - Less revenue – seniors buy more services and less goods: goods are taxed services are not
- **Transportation**
  - Need for more transit
  - Need for more door to door service
  - Transportation patterns likely to change
- **Business Development**
  - New services
  - More door to door service
  - More health care and wellness services
- **Housing**
  - Increased demand for affordable /accessible
  - Increased demand for subsidized housing
- **Community design**
  - Increased need for walkable communities
  - Need for thoughtful community design that supports independence
- **Health Care and Services**
  - Increased need services in home
  - Increased community based services
  - Increase chronic disease self management programs and prevention programs
  - Need to manage health care costs

# Growth in Medicaid out paces the General Fund

Cumulative Growth Rates from FY 13-14 through FY 29-30 for GF and SEF Revenues, CDE, and HCPF
