The U.S. Constitution protects all citizens against searches and seizure of their private information. The Constitution applies to minors and attendance in a public school does not waive these rights.

Assessment questions and answers coupled with technological advancements can be processed to mine for "meta data." This opens the door to profiling students according to personal preferences, cultural, racial, religious, political, economic, social, and psychological tendencies. Participation is mandated by law.

Profiling in order to predict behavior and effect the life and opportunities of American citizens has long been suspect, discouraged and in many cases illegal.

Constitutional rights are truly inconvenient in the wake of the expanding arm of government.

So now? – the public is rising up. The actions of Rosa Parks in refusing to comply with government mandates that violate civil rights is being echoed by parents refusing to testing and data collection.

The current practices in schools are shocking! Children are being treated like lab rats and those who do not have the means ... are stuck in the experiment. Our governments and administrators have put their priority interest in data collection over the wellbeing of our children.

WE ARE HERE TODAY BECAUSE THE CURRENT LEGISLATION IS NOT WORKING. Lawsuits are imminent.

This bill gives you an opportunity to stem the flow of this tide.

It is narrowly tailored and balances the interests of the state and schools, with the interests of the civil rights of the individuals those schools are supposed to serve. This legislation addresses the problem in a way that accommodates the diversity that makes up the American classroom.

Current contracts and laws have divested our administrators of the ability to provide oversight and protection for their students. Schools are forced to essentially violate our civil rights –

Unfortunately the political parties are more concerned with party control than representing the interests of the people who elected them. This bill is sponsored by a Republican, how much does that weigh in your decision? The Democratic party used to be the party for embracing diversity, standing for the civil rights and equal protection of the laws... But now, the only place Democrats will stand, is against the Republicans.
