

**UPDATED SUMMARY
HOUSE BILL 15-1341**

First Regular Session - Seventieth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

Currently, sexual exploitation of a child by possession of sexually exploitative material is a class 6 felony for first-time offenses and a class 4 felony if the possession is of a video, a recording or broadcast of moving visual images, a motion picture or more than 20 different items (video or more than 20 items), or if it is a second or subsequent offense. The bill increases current class 6 felonies to class 5 felonies. The bill also changes the term "video tape" to "recording or broadcast of moving visual images".
