After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB15-1267 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 3, strike lines 8 through 12 and substitute "THE  
2 COURT SHALL NOT, AS A CONDITION OF PROBATION, PROHIBIT THE  
3 POSSESSION OR USE OF MEDICAL MARIJUANA, AS AUTHORIZED PURSUANT  
4 TO SECTION 14 OF ARTICLE XVIII OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION, UNLESS:  
5 (A) THE DEFENDANT IS SENTENCED TO PROBATION FOR  
6 CONVICTION OF A CRIME UNDER ARTICLE 43.3 OF TITLE 12, C.R.S.; OR  
7 (B) THE COURT DETERMINES, BASED ON THE ASSESSMENT AS  
8 REQUIRED BY SECTION 18-1.3-209, A PROHIBITION AGAINST THE  
9 POSSESSION OR USE OF MEDICAL MARIJUANA IS NECESSARY AND  
10 APPROPRIATE TO ACCOMPLISH THE GOALS OF SENTENCING AS STATED IN  
11 18-1-102.5".
