

UPDATED SUMMARY
HOUSE BILL 15-1267

First Regular Session - Seventieth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

Under current law, a person on probation is prohibited from committing another offense. The possession and use of marijuana is an offense under federal law.

The bill makes an exception to the probation conditions for the possession and use of medical marijuana pursuant to the state constitution *unless*:

- ! The person is convicted of an offense related to medical marijuana; or*
- ! The court determines that prohibiting the use of medical marijuana is necessary to further the goals of sentencing.*
