

**UPDATED SUMMARY
SENATE BILL 15-235**

First Regular Session - Seventieth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

Joint Budget Committee. Under current law, the general assembly may annually appropriate up to \$1,500,000 to the department of education to allow school food authorities to provide free lunches for children enrolled in state-subsidized public preschool programs, kindergarten, or grades 1 through 5 who would otherwise be required to pay a reduced price for lunch. The bill increases the limit to \$2,500,000 for the 2014-15 budget year and budget years thereafter.
