Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation of \$1,856,635 General Fund to the Department of Human Services for use by the Division of Child Welfare. Of these funds, \$1.5 million is for allocation to parties of the Collaborative Management Program memoranda of understanding; \$106,635 is for administration of the program; and \$250,000 is for the annual external evaluation of the program.
