

**UPDATED SUMMARY
HOUSE BILL 16-1462**

Second Regular Session - Seventieth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

House Bill 11-1155 authorized the lieutenant governor to also serve concurrently as the head of a principal department of state government. The bill allows the lieutenant governor to similarly serve as a ~~governor's office appointee~~ *the state chief operating officer* through the remainder of the current term of the lieutenant governor. The total amount of salary paid to the lieutenant governor is limited to the amount that would be paid for service as the head of a principal department or a ~~governor's office appointee~~ *the state chief operating officer*.
