

**UPDATED SUMMARY
HOUSE BILL 16-1122**

Second Regular Session - Seventieth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

Current law prohibits the idling of an unattended vehicle. The bill makes an exception for vehicles with a remote starter system when the driver takes adequate security measures.

The bill specifies that local authorities may enforce or enact ordinances or resolutions concerning time limits on the idling of motor vehicles within one year after the effective date of the bill.
