

**UPDATED SUMMARY
HOUSE BILL 16-1186**

Second Regular Session - Seventieth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

In any year in which the state is required to contribute a 20% grant match for federal grants under the federal "Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act" for rail fixed guideway system safety oversight, the bill directs the state treasurer to transfer the first \$150,000 collected from public utilities as annual fees into the Colorado public utilities commission's fixed utility fund to meet Colorado's grant match obligation.

The bill appropriates \$150,000 from the public utilities commission fixed utility fund to the department of regulatory agencies for use by the public utilities commission.
