

UPDATED SUMMARY
SENATE BILL 16-134

Second Regular Session - Seventieth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

~~**Section 1** of the bill requires the Colorado department of public health and environment (CDPHE) to consider crediting a military veteran's training, education, and experience toward the qualifications for certification as an emergency medical service provider.~~

Section 2 1 of the bill requires the Colorado department of revenue (DOR) to consider crediting a military veteran's training, education, and experience toward the qualifications for a commercial driver's license.

Section 3 2 of the bill requires the division of veterans affairs to make reasonable efforts to notify a discharged member of the obligations of ~~CDPHE and DOR~~ under ~~sections 1 and 2~~ of the bill and of the duties and functions of a professional licensing authority that is regulated by the department of regulatory agencies.
