BILL TOPIC: COUNTY COURT JUDGE RESIDENCE PREFERENCES

Summary of Legislation

This bill encourages a judicial district nominating commission, when making recommendations for a vacant county judgeship, to give preference to attorneys who:

- are licensed to practice in Colorado; and
- reside within the county in which the vacancy occurs.

Assessment

This bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact because it does not alter the revenue or expenditures for any unit of state or local government.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on May 27, 2016, and takes effect August 10, 2016, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
