UPDATED SUMMARY HOUSE BILL 16-1287

Second Regular Session - Seventieth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

The bill requires the department of labor and employment to study the barriers to the use of pre-apprenticeship and apprenticeship programs by Colorado businesses and make a report and recommendations based on the study.

The report and recommendations that come from the study must be provided to the state work force development council for inclusion in the annual Colorado talent report, to the senate business, labor, and technology committee, and to the house business affairs and labor committee.
