27 Page 4, line 12, after "REVIEW." insert "EACH BUILDING DEPARTMENT'S
 28 STANDARD PROCEDURES NEED NOT REQUIRE A CONTEMPORANEOUS
 29 REVIEW FOR EACH AND EVERY INSPECTION OF A PROJECT, BUT THE
 30 PROCEDURES MUST PRESERVE AN INSPECTOR'S ABILITY TO VERIFY
 31 COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 12-23-105 AND 12-23-110.5 AT ANY TIME."
